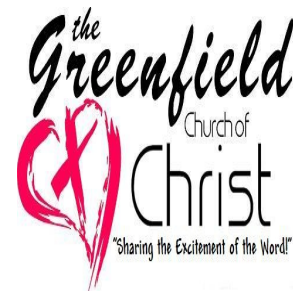

*From David's Desk* Doubting Thomas

"Raised from the dead? Impossible! It couldn't have happened!"  
When Thomas heard about it, he didn't hold back—he told the other disciples that he didn't believe it.  
"Unless I see the nail marks in his hands, and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it."  
He'd just couldn't believe that someone could come back from the dead. Jesus was dead. Thomas kind of reminds me of people today who want proof before they believe something. "That just doesn't make sense," they would say. "It didn't happen." But what if it did happen?  
Thomas was convinced when Jesus appeared to him, reached out his hands to Thomas, and said, "Put your finger here."  
Thomas dropped to his knees and said, "My Lord and my God!"  
Jesus' resurrection from the dead is why we Christians make such a big deal about Easter. That is why we celebrate.  
For me, Jesus rising from the dead means that death isn't the end of the story. Even if my body ends up in the ground, I have real hope because Jesus, raised by God, promises eternal life to anyone who believes in him and is baptized. This belief makes me feel braver and brings a sense of calm, reminding me life matters and death doesn't have the last word. For Christians, knowing we'll be raised, too, changes how we deal with tough times or saying goodbye—it brings comfort and helps us stick together. We find strength and hope as a community, even when things get hard.

*He's alive, that's what Easter is all about!*

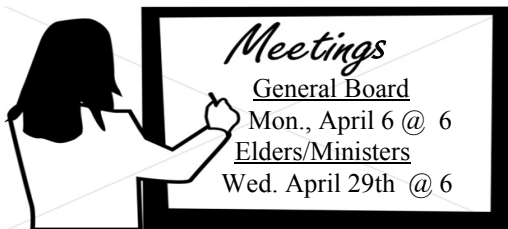
