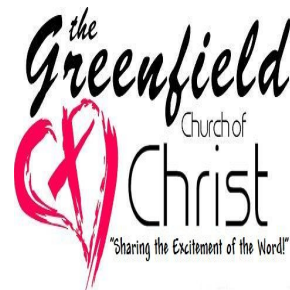
Welcome to **Shelly Lawwell**, who was baptized into Christ on May 21st.

It says in Galatians 5:16-17, ¹⁶So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

Every day of our lives, we are in a spiritual battle where we are bombarded with temptations that appeal to our human nature, and it is with these temptations that our enemy, the Devil strikes at us. God has given us a way to defend ourselves and to fight back, but are we willing to use what we have been given and stand strong. There is a story I once heard that illustrates how, if we let it, temptation can overpower us and ultimately overcome us.

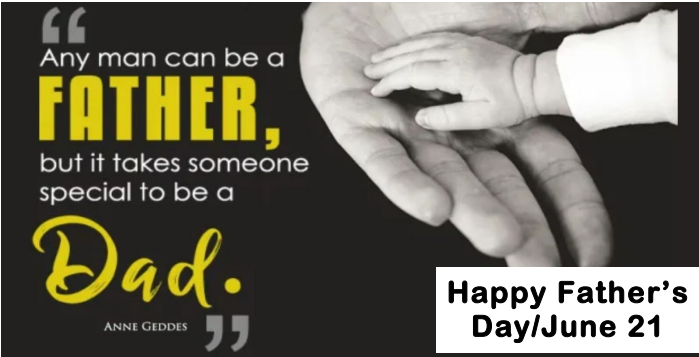
