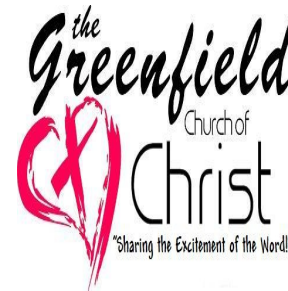

Let's be used by God

27 But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. 28 God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, 29 so that no one may boast before him . (1 Corinthians 1:27-29)

There’s an old story which goes something like this: When Jesus ascended into heaven, he gathered his heavenly hosts around and explained what he would do next. He said he would take the weak, sinful, frail, and filthy people that he saved and use them as living stones to build the foundation of his kingdom on earth. *These* would be the ones to change the world! The announcement was welcomed with an overwhelming silence. Then, after a long, agonizing pause, the angel Gabriel broke the silence by asking, “*What’s plan B?*” There is no plan B, because God’s plan has always been to use people like us – weak, sinful, frail, and filthy – to show the wonders of his grace that are the foundation of hope for this world.
