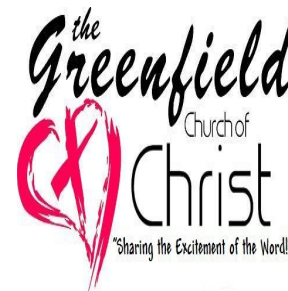

From David's Desk

A 19th-century Danish theologian identified two kinds of religion – Religion A and Religion B.

Religion A is "faith" in the name of religion only. * Webster dictionary defines "Religion" as, "a particular system of belief or worship built around God, moral ideals, a philosophy of life, etc." It's the practice of attending church without genuine faith in the living God. 2 Timothy 3:5 warns us against that type of religion when it says;

(2 Tim. 3:5 "They will act as if they are religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly. You must stay away from people like that.") *

Religion B, on the other hand, is a life-transforming, destiny-changing experience. It's a definite commitment to the crucified and risen Savior, which establishes an ongoing personal relationship between a forgiven sinner and a gracious God.

The sad thing is that there are a large number of "Christians" in the world who take part in Religion A and never make that commitment to letting Christ fully take hold of their life.

I pray that as you go on this journey called life, you look to God to take control and choose Religion B or Religion A.

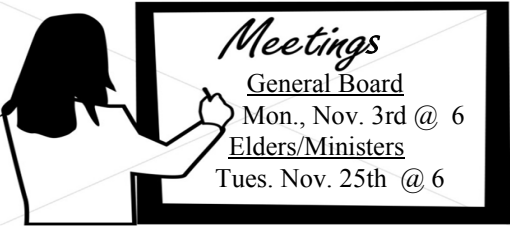
