### From Davíd's Desk

In today's fast-paced and ever-changing world, standing up as a Christian can be challenging.

There are so many things that the world says are correct, which are in direct opposition to what we believe. However, it is precisely in these times that standing up for God becomes even more crucial. Standing up for God means living out our faith boldly and authentically. It involves making choices that reflect our beliefs, even when they are unpopular or misunderstood.

One of the main ways of standing up for God is having the courage to speak out. It means being willing to have open and honest conversations about what you believe and being prepared to answer questions and address doubts.

If you haven't been at Greenfield Church of Christ in a while, we have been exploring the "Life in 6 Words" framework: GOD, OUR, SINS, PAYING, EVERYONE, LIFE. Here's a brief explanation of each word to help clarify what they mean:

- GOD God created us to be with Him, inviting us into a loving relationship.
- OUR Our sins separate us from God, creating a barrier between us and His presence.
- SINS Sins cannot be removed by good deeds; no amount of effort can erase what separates us from Him.
- PAYING Jesus paid the price for our sins by dying on the cross and rising again, making forgiveness possible.
- EVERYONE Everyone who believes in Him and is baptized will have eternal life; salvation is available to all.
- LIFE Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever, offering hope and purpose both today and for eternity.


