FLIPSIDE / S.A.I. L. Seniors Active In Life

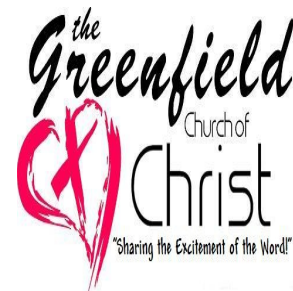

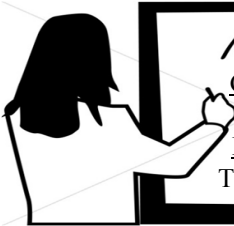

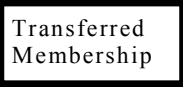
