Guidance on how to avoid catching or spreading coronavirus (COVID-19)

- ✓ Wash your hands with soap and water often - do this for at least 20 seconds.
- ✓ Always wash your hands when you get home or into work.
- ✓ Use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) if you cough or sneeze.
- ✓ Put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards.
- ✓ Try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell.

How to handwash

WITH SOAP AND WATER



2









Duration of entire procedure

40-60 seconds

Wet hands with water

Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces

Rub hands palm to palm

Rub back of each hand with the palm of the other hand with fingers interlaced

Rub palm to palm with fingers interlaced

Rub with backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlaced



Rub each thumb clasped in opposite hand using rotational movement



Rub tips of fingers in opposite palm in a circular motion



Rinse hands with water



Dry roughly with a single-use towel



Use towel to turn off tap



Your hands are now safe

Duration of entire procedure

20-30 seconds

How to handrub

WITH ALCOHOLIC HANDRUB (containing at least 60% alcohol)



Apply a small amount of the product (about 3ml) into a cupped hand



Apply enough to cover all hand surfaces



Rub hands palm to palm



Rub back of each hand with the palm of the other hand with fingers interlaced



Rub palm to palm with fingers interlaced



Rub with backs of fingers Rub each thumb clasped to opposing palms with in opposite hand using fingers interlaced rotational movement



Rub tips of fingers in opposite palm in a circular motion



When dry, your hands are now safe
