



5. I do not believe the phone call was “cordial.” I felt personally threatened and intimidated by Mayor Walsh, particularly because he mentioned “lawsuits” multiple times and the difficulty that comes with lawsuits.

6. A few minutes after our phone call ended, I called Mayor Walsh back to let him know that his call was “extremely offensive.” Mayor Walsh “did not ask for any clarification or ask if I had any knowledge of the situation.” Instead, he immediately started to strongly impress upon me the seriousness of certain behaviors and the litigation that could come from them.

7. I have since learned that the text message I sent to my friend, Blair Mileski, was the purported reason behind Mayor Walsh’s phone call.

8. Mr. Mileski and I are good friends and he knew that my text message to him was in jest.
