What is Shadow Banning?

 A form of content suppression where your posts are hidden or deprioritized.

Why Conservative Voices Get Censored:

 Big Tech biases, controversial topics, and "misinformation" claims.

What You Can Do to Combat It:

 Consistent posting, using alternate platforms, and diversifying content.





6. The Power of Twitter and Elon Musk's Promise to Free Speech

Twitter as a Conservative Hub:

 Fast-paced engagement, visibility through hashtags.

Elon Musk's Role:

 Vow to protect free speech and reduce censorship.

Avoid arguments aimed to Distract, Derail or Divide.

Common Tactics to Watch Out For:

- Identity politics: race, gender, class.
 Gaslighting by opposition groups.
 Ad Hominem Attacks

Stay on message and uphold a Republican standard of respect.



9. The Republican Standard for Online Engagement

Focus on Policy, Not Personal Attacks.

Encourage Constructive Discussions.

Try NOT to engage in frivolous arguments; aim for meaningful discourse.

Support Fellow Conservatives.

Uplift and share conservative content regularly.
