

## Voice of Triumph

"You also will command the nations, and they will come running to obey, not because of your own power or virtue, but because I, the Lord your God, have glorified you," Isaiah 55:5, (TLB)

THE GLORY LIGHT INHABITS YOU AS YOU RESIDE IN GOD'S PRESENCE

The glory is the manifest presence of God upon you: "The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise (halal) i.e., "to shine" the LORD that seek Him: your heart shall live for ever," Psalm 22:26, (KJV). God's glory adorned Moses: "Moses was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights; he ate no bread and drank no water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments. When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tables of the Testimony in his hand, he did not know that the skin of his face shone and sent forth beams by reason of his speaking with the Lord. When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone, and they feared to come near him. But Moses called to them; and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and [he] talked with them. Afterward all the Israelites came near, and he gave them in commandment all the Lord had said to him in Mount Sinai. And when Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil on his face. But when Moses went in before the Lord to speak with Him, he took the veil off until he came out. And he came out and told the Israelites what he was commanded. The Israelites saw the face of Moses, how the skin of it shone; and Moses put the veil on his face again until he went in to speak with God," Ex. 34:28-35, (AMPC). God's glory shall adorn you: "Why should not the dispensation of the Spirit [this spiritual ministry whose task it is to cause men to obtain and be governed by the Holy Spirit] be attended with much greater and more splendid glory? For if the service that condemns [the ministration of doom] had glory, how infinitely more abounding in splendor and glory must be the service that makes righteous [the ministry that produces and fosters righteous living and right standing with God]! Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom). And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendor and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit," 2 Cor. 3:8-9, 17-18 (AMPC).

## THE GLORY LIGHT WAS MADE BEFORE THE SUN, MOON, AND THE STARS

God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit i.e., *Elohim* created the glory light: "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light," Gen. 1:1-3. Jesus the Glory Light was born as a man on earth with a spirit in a body with a soul: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not [can't overpower it]," Jn. 1:1-5. Jesus' Glory Revealed: "The people who had been living in darkness have seen a great light. The light of life has shined on those who dwelt in the shadowy darkness of death," Is. 9:2, (Voice). "All this will flow from the kind and compassionate mercy of our God. A new day is dawning: the Sunrise from the heavens will break through in our darkness, And those who huddle in night, those who sit in the shadow of death, will be able to rise and walk in the light, guided in the pathway of peace," Luke 1:78-79, (Voice).
