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PLANT THE HEAVENS: BELIEVE GOD AND VOICE-ACTIVATE HIS WORD

By faith, Abraham and Sarah mirrored God’s model to be fruitful, multiply, replenish, subdue, and have dominion. “Hearken to Me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the Lord: look unto the rock whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged. Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him. For the Lord shall comfort Zion: He will comfort all her waste places; and He will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the Lord; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody,” Is. 51:1-3. By faith, be God’s chosen mouthpiece to mirror His model. “And I have put My words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of Mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art My people,” Is. 51:16.

GENESIS GAVE YOU CREATION AND REVELATION GIVES YOU RECREATION

The tree of life was God’s endorsed choice for renewal and revival, but the free will has the final choice: “And the Lord God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there He put the man whom He had formed. And out of the ground made the Lord God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads,” Gen. 2:8-10. With God as your endorsed choice, the tree of life are on both sides of the street: “And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations,” Rev. 22:1-2. With every choice, choose life!

THE PLANTING OF THE LORD: THE BRANCH LINKS THE VINE TO THE FRUIT

God’s Assembly Line: “I am the True Vine, and My Father is the husbandman. Every branch in Me that beareth not fruit He taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the *logos* word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing. If a man abide not in Me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in Me, and my *rhema* words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is My Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be My disciples. Ye have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My name, He may give it you,” John 15:1-8, 16. God’s Profitable Produce is the Fruit of the Spirit: “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law,” Gal. 5:22-23. Jesus’ Taste Test: “Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit,” Matt 12:33. Your Forefather’s David Endorsed Delight: “O taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in Him,” Psalm 34:8. Jesus and Holy Spirit are heaven’s source, supply, and surplus to meet every demand. So thrive!

STRONG ROOTS RENEWED AND REVIVED FLOURISH IN HARVEST

Your Seed Time: “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper,” Ps. 1:1-3. Your Harvest Time: “The [uncompromisingly] righteous shall flourish like the palm tree [be long-lived, stately, upright, useful, and fruitful]; they shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon [majestic, stable, durable, and incorruptible]. Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God. [Growing in grace] they shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be full of sap [of spiritual vitality] and [rich in the] verdure [of trust, love, and contentment]. [They are living memorials] to show that the Lord is upright *and* faithful to His promises; He is my Rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him,” Psalm 92:12-15, AMPC. May you be a tree of life who lives long to stand strong as you plant your Garden of Eden.

Thought for Transformation

Jesus outlasted Crucifixion. The cross He carried was from the tree He created. He needed help to carry it. He saw you living through Him as His implanted branch, so stays affixed to help carry yours too. Do what Jesus did when He faced overwhelming opposition. He resurrected!

You Carve what You Crave

Prov. 15:4 leads to the abundant life. “A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.” Wrong words court chaos. In Hebrew, perverseness is “cranky, self-defeating, stubbornly unreasonable.” Job ate fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. “And said, Naked came I out of my mother’s womb, and naked shall I return thither: the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord,” Job 1: 21. Once Job refused to be torn between two opinions, he prophesied his, ours, and Jesus’ Resurrection.

“For there is hope of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease. Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stock thereof die in the ground; Yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant,” Job 14:7-9. Use your words to carve out renewal and revival!
