WELCOME TO SUMMER

As we move into the heart of the summer season, we are pleased to share several updates from around The Cove. The past few months have brought continued progress across operations, property improvements, sales efforts, and guest experiences. With summer underway and activity increasing throughout Lake Geneva, we remain focused on enhancing the owner and guest experience while positioning the property for continued success.

Operations & Guest Experience:

May marked a major milestone as we completed the first full month operating on the Agilysys Versa PMS and InfoGenesis systems. We continue to work closely with Agilysys on implementation support, staff training, system configuration, and ongoing optimization efforts. All systems are now live and actively supporting daily operations.



Guest satisfaction remained strong throughout this transition period. In May, we received 69 new guest reviews with an average rating of 4.4 out of 5 stars. Positive feedback continues to reflect our team's commitment to providing a quality guest experience while adapting to new systems and processes.

Financial & Accounting Updates

The Accounting team successfully completed the transition from Lodgical, M3, and CLA to Agilysys Versa, QuickBooks, and our new on-site accounting partner, McLeod Accounting. This transition provides the property with greater direct oversight of financial operations, streamlined processes, and improved efficiency. As we continue enhancing our financial systems and procedures, owners can expect a more transparent and improved financial experience.

Owners have already received brand-new, modern financial statements beginning with the May 2026 reporting period, providing clearer insights into the property's financial performance.

- **Enhanced Accuracy:** Beginning in July 2026, owners' revenue share distributions will be deposited on the 20th of each month, with association dues processed separately on the 21st. Separating these transactions provides greater transparency and ensures the highest level of accuracy for owner accounts.
- **Stronger Financial Planning:** We are developing advanced budgeting, forecasting, and financial reporting tools that will provide deeper insights and support more strategic decision-making for the future of The Cove.

Revenue & Performance:

Room View Pricing Strategy Implemented
premium pricing for room view categories:

- Nature Preserve View: +\$20 over Standard View
- Pool View: +\$30 over Standard View
- These premiums will be actively monitored and adjusted based on occupancy levels, demand patterns, and seasonality to maximize revenue opportunities.
- By introducing view-based pricing, The Cove is now capturing additional value from desirable room locations that was previously not reflected in our rate structure. This enhancement is expected to drive incremental revenue growth and improve Average Daily Rate (ADR).

Looking ahead:

Summer demand continues to strengthen, with weekends remaining the primary driver of occupancy and Thursdays also showing consistently strong performance. Revenue management strategies continue to focus on maximizing occupancy while optimizing average daily rate during peak demand periods.

Upcoming High-Demand Dates

- July 3–4: Fourth of July holiday period with strong demand and continued booking pace.



- July 17–18: Increased demand associated with the Country Thunder festival.
- July 22–23: Additional room demand generated by the Lake State Lumber Association event.
- Throughout July and August: Weekend occupancy remains strong, with continued opportunities to drive revenue through strategic pricing and inventory management.

The Revenue Management team will continue monitoring booking pace, market demand, and competitive positioning to maximize occupancy and revenue opportunities throughout the summer season.

Sales & Business

Development:

Sales and business development efforts remained active throughout the month, with a continued focus on networking, industry engagement, prospecting, and future group business opportunities.

- The Cove strengthened its community and industry presence through participation in additional organizations, networking groups, and professional development opportunities.
- We are also pleased to share that General Manager Sam Kelly was appointed to the Downtown Lake Geneva BID Board of Directors.
- Director of Sales Susan Williams returned to the property and, along with the Sales & Marketing Team, participated in several site visits and property tours throughout the region, including visits to area the Abbey Resort, Lake Lawn Resort, The Grand Geneva and Timber Ridge to gather ideas, strengthen

industry relationships, and identify opportunities to enhance The Cove's offerings.

- The Director of Sales, Senior Sales Manager, and Sales & Events Manager met with Jill Gaulke, Destination Sales Manager with Visit Lake Geneva, for their quarterly business review. Discussions focused on outstanding RFPs, future opportunities, and prospective business that may be a good fit for The Cove.
- Sales continues to actively prospect both new and past clients to secure group room blocks, meetings, and events for 2026 and 2027.
- The Cove hosted a media familiarization tour with Geiger & Associates Public Relations. This opportunity introduced additional travel and tourism media representatives to the property and highlighted the amenities and experiences available to future visitors.

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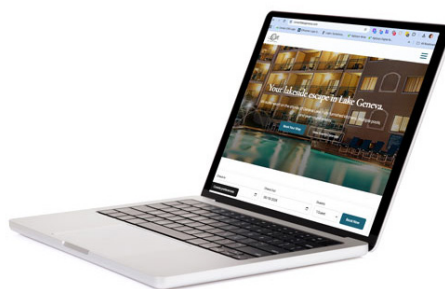
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- Following connections made at the Circle Wisconsin Conference, The Cove hosted a site tour with Go Rite Transportation. Their team specifically requested to visit The Cove after meeting with Sam Kelly and Daneen Soliday and expressed strong interest in future partnership opportunities.
- During the month, The Cove hosted a cheerleading group utilizing approximately 70 guestrooms. The success of this event has already generated additional business, with a second cheerleading group anticipated in July utilizing 15–20 guestrooms over a two-night stay.
- Group sales inquiries continue to remain strong for late 2026 and throughout 2027. Wedding room blocks are also showing positive momentum. The Sales Team remains focused on growing weekday business, maximizing peak-season opportunities, and securing future group demand.

Marketing & Community Engagement:

Marketing efforts during the month focused on promoting summer occupancy, expanding community partnerships, and developing future events designed to drive visitation and increase awareness of The Cove.

As part of our recent transition to new group sales and booking software, The Cove has launched a new website. We will continue making updates, enhancements, and improvements as we move forward, and we appreciate your patience as we identify and correct any issues that may arise.



We encourage you to explore the new site and let us know if you encounter anything that doesn't seem to be working properly.

Looking ahead:

Several entertainment and community events are currently planned or under development, including:

- NEW Dueling Pianos returns to The Cove on August 21, 2026, and again on November 6, 2026, following previous sold-out performances.
- Psychic Medium Sheri Jewel returning October 3, 2026
- Logan Ramey's Elvis Tribute Show planned for March 2027.



- Halloween-themed entertainment and special events planned for October 2026.
- A potential Holiday Vendor Fair in November 2026.
- The proposed "Answering the Call Luncheon," honoring police, fire, EMS, and other public safety professionals in our community.

Community engagement continues through our Cove Cares program. For July, The Cove has selected three veterans organizations serving the 53147 area to receive Cove Cares donations. Funds raised throughout the month will be divided equally among the three organizations.

In support of this initiative, The Cove introduced new patriotic-themed staff shirts for the summer season. The shirts have generated significant interest from guests, many of whom have asked to purchase them. As a result, additional shirts have been ordered and will be made available for sale. The Cove will donate \$10 from each shirt sold to the July Cove Cares campaign, helping support local veterans organizations while providing guests with an opportunity to contribute to the cause. These efforts are designed to increase awareness of The Cove, drive occupancy, generate additional revenue opportunities, and strengthen our connection to both visitors and the local community.

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Maintenance & Property Improvements:

Significant progress has been made across the property, with a continued focus on both guest-facing enhancements and infrastructure improvements.

CURRENT AND ONGOING PROJECTS INCLUDE:

- Additional speed bump installation and painting throughout the property to improve traffic flow and guest safety.
- Lobby restroom repairs and improvements.
- Dishwasher installation project.

Looking Ahead for the Property:

The Cove's focus remains on delivering an exceptional guest experience while maximizing revenue opportunities, enhancing owner value, and strengthening our connection to the Lake Geneva community.

Early indicators show June continuing to be a strong month, with total revenue pacing ahead of June 2025. Summer demand remains healthy, supported by strong weekend occupancy, special events, and continued growth in group and leisure travel.

As the community celebrates Independence Day and America's 250th anniversary, The Cove will participate in Lake Geneva's Liberty on the Lake festivities. In support of July's Cove Cares campaign benefiting local veterans organizations, staff will be wearing special red, white, and blue patriotic shirts throughout the holiday period. Due to

strong guest interest, these shirts will also be available for purchase, with a portion of each sale benefiting the July Cove Cares fundraising effort.

The Cove remains committed to investing in the property, growing revenue opportunities, supporting our community, and creating memorable experiences for both owners and guests.

Owner Update

As we enter the busy summer season, we would like to share a few reminders and updates to help ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all owners and guests.

DOG WALKING

All owner pets and service animals should be walked along the exterior areas of the parking lot and not in the grass areas immediately adjacent to the building.

SMOKING POLICY

The Cove is a smoke-free property. Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the building, on balconies, patios, or within 20 feet of the property. Please share this policy with family members, friends, and guests. Violations may result in a \$250 fee.

QUIET HOURS

Quiet hours are in effect from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM for all guests, *whether staying in rental or non-rental units*. Disturbances may result in a \$250 fee and guests may be asked to leave the property. Any applicable fees will be charged to the homeowner.

KEURIG REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

All Keurig coffee makers in rental units will be replaced by June 30, 2026.

PARKING REMINDERS

Please ensure that all vehicles display the proper owner or guest parking pass. Additional overnight guest parking passes are available, based on availability, for \$35 per pass. Unauthorized vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense.

POOL WRISTBANDS

Owners and guests must obtain wristbands from the Front Desk upon arrival. One wristband will be issued per person for the duration of the stay. Please stop by the Front Desk and let us know you have arrived.

Reminder: Outside alcoholic beverages and glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.

All guests must wear a wristband to enter the pool area. No exceptions.

RENTAL OWNER CHECK-IN REQUIREMENTS

Guests staying in rental units must present a valid photo ID and provide a credit card for incidental authorization at check-in.

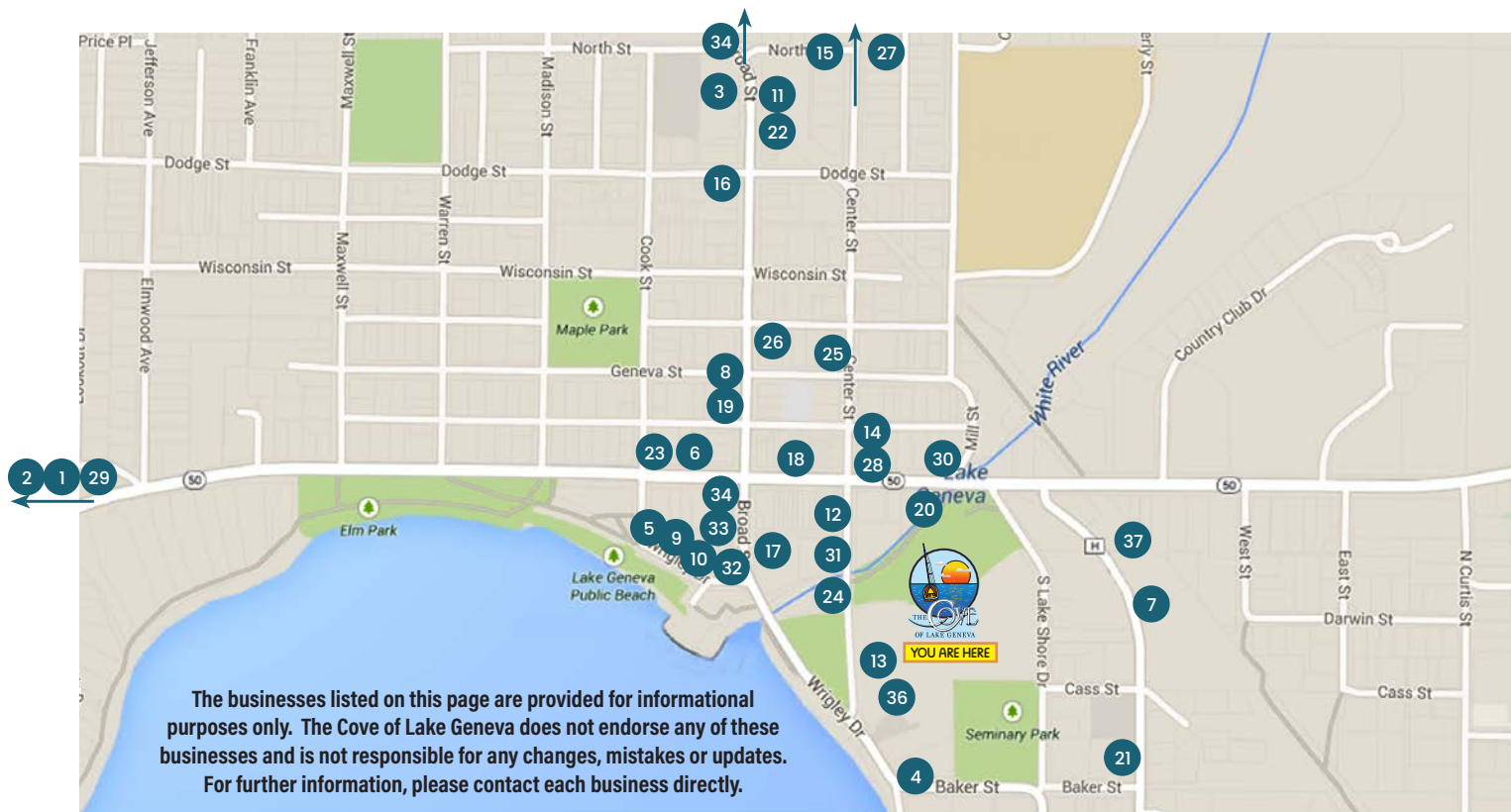
