





# Our Mission

To provide clean drinking water to those in need, enhance health and well being, and make a difference in people's lives.

# Our Vision

- To improve impoverished communities around the world, promoting sanitation and hygiene for the well-being of all citizens.
- To decrease water borne deaths and diseases
- To promote school attendance for children
- To reduce risk of being kidnapped for human/sex trafficking.
- To support economic sustainability



# The Problem

For millions of families, getting water is not simple or safe. Water sources are often contaminated, distant, or unreliable — forcing daily tradeoffs between health, education, and safety.

Without clean water:

- Preventable diseases spread quickly
- Children are prone to miss school due to illnesses
- Journeys to get water can average more than 3 miles through long and dangerous terrain
- Women and children face increased exposure to violence and human/sex-trafficking
- Communities remain locked in cycles of instability and poverty

**Water is not just a basic need; it is the foundation of public health, education, and economic life. When access is unsafe or uncertain, everything else is at risk.**

# Our Approach

We partner directly with communities in need and build ELECTRIC SUBMERSIBLE PUMP POWERED WELLS, that provide reliable, clean drinking water for **generations**.

Before construction begins, each community agrees to:

- Community-owned land for the water site
- Local responsibility for maintenance and management
- Ongoing progress documentation and reporting during the building phase
- Access for every community member

This ensures **empowerment, shared ownership, and sustainability**.



# Effects of Clean Water

## IMPROVED HEALTH

- Reduced waterborne diseases
- Increased hygiene
- Improved sanitation

## EDUCATION

- Increased school attendance
- Improved academic performance due to increased retention and focus

## SAFETY & SECURITY

- Reduced long and/or dangerous walks
- Reduced exposure to violence from humans or animals
- Lowers exposure to exploitation and sex-trafficking



# Our Impact

Give Water Give Life has grown across two nations on the African continent: the nation of Nigeria, West Africa, the birthplace and community of our founder, and Uganda, East Africa.

To date, our work has:

- Provided clean drinking water to **12 communities across two nations**
- Reached approximately **30,000 people**
- Supported a variety of communities including **schools, orphanages and health clinics**

# One of Many Success Stories

## GOD'S LOVE ORPHANAGE/SCHOOL

Southern Uganda

The orphanage/school called God's Love in Southern Uganda was condemned to be shut down by the Uganda Ministry of Health in September 2023, due to lack of clean water, resulting in a unhygienic and unsanitary conditions.

When this information came to Give Water Give Life, we **quickly** intervened by providing a clean drinking water resource for the orphanage within one month.

As a result of the work of Give Water Give Life, the orphanage was saved. **It remains open today and serves over 1000 children.**



# Another Success Story

## TOSORO VILLAGE

Visually impaired community in Eastern Uganda

Give Water Give Life helped a visually impaired community in Tosoro village in Eastern Uganda. They were suffering from a lack of access to clean water. While traveling to get water many of the villagers would fall and suffer injuries. Obstacles and ditches increased the risks of injury/harm.

When the news came to Give Water Give Life, we provided their community with a permanent clean water station in **less than one month**. Allowing them access to clean drinking water right where they live.
