

Professional Review Subcommittee

The Professional Review Subcommittee, often referred to as the PRSC, is a subcommittee of the Lansdowne Conservancy Covenants Committee. Article 9 of the Declaration of the Lansdowne Conservancy provides for the oversight of all development within Lansdowne by the Covenants Committee. The PRSC was established by the Lansdowne Conservancy Board of Directors to support the Covenants Committee in an administrative and advisory capacity. The PRSC consists of professionals with backgrounds in engineering, architecture, landscaping, planning, and who reviews, processes, and makes recommendations to the Covenants Committee on all development applications. The design review and approval process can be found in the Lansdowne Conservancy Design Guidelines as amended July 2016.

Jackie Harlow is the Project Manager for the PRSC and reports the PRSC's activity and findings to the Covenants Committee and Board of Directors. She is a Land Use Planner employed by Turner Holden and Turner Law Firm in Leesburg, Virginia. Prior to becoming the PRSC's Project Manager in 2016, she worked for Loudoun County Government reviewing both administrative and legislative land development applications including subdivisions, construction plans, rezonings and special exceptions. She is instrumental in maintaining a working relationship with Loudoun County and communicating the Conservancy's role in the development of land within Lansdowne.
