Good News! Those folks who do not have access to our online worship service will be able to come to the church for worship beginning Sunday, February 7. **We strongly encourage you not to come to church if you can access our worship service from home through technology.** The Church Council is closely monitoring the situation with the Covid virus and will update you as to when more worshippers will be allowed to come back to our beautiful sanctuary.

Out of an abundance of caution, we will be using a forehead temperature scanner on all those in attendance when you enter the church, much like you have taken when you go to the doctor's office or dentist office. **Please, DO NOT come to church if you are not feeling well that particular day.** We will continue taking attendance and keep the required contact tracing.

**Masks will be required of worshippers in the building at all times whether seated or standing,** except for the worship team while they are upfront leading the service. **You will need to continue to social distance, except for those who live in the same household. There will still be sanitization stations available and you are asked to sanitize the restroom if you should use it. Supplies will be available for this purpose.**

You have been tremendously faithful during this difficult time. For this, we thank you! The offering plate will be placed on a small table in the back of the sanctuary like it has been in recent months.
