PRESS RELEASE

On May 1st at 9:33 PM, the Claremont Fire Department was dispatched to the area of Veterans Park, along the ATV trail, for a reported brush fire that was spreading. C-1, Brush 1, and Engine 4 responded. Crews arrived on scene at 9:38 PM and located an active brush fire approximately 60 by 60 feet in size, off the ATV trail.

Fire personnel used the ATV trail for access and established a 2.5-inch supply line. Fire personnel were able to contain and extinguish the fire, preventing any further spread. The scene was brought under control at 10:01 PM.

Claremont fire crews are working with the Claremont Police Department and the District Forest Ranger as part of an ongoing investigation. If anyone has information regarding the cause of this fire, please contact the Claremont Fire Department at 603-542-5156.

No injuries were reported.

The Claremont Fire Department would like to remind all residents that an active burn permit is required before kindling any outdoor fire, including campfires and brush piles. Permits can be obtained by calling the department or visiting the fire station in person.
