From the Pastor,

Working at camp, one of our most effective teaching tools was storytelling. Among my favorite stories from those days is still "Barrington Bunny," by Martin Bell. While the story is too long to share in its entirety (and probably would be a violation of copyright laws), let me share the essence of the story with you.

Barrington is a lop-eared bunny who believes he is alone in the forest on Christmas Eve. He hops from potential friend to potential friend looking for a family to be with for that special night. But the squirrel family and mouse family and beaver family are all at a loss on how to include this furry bunny in their tree or hole or river den homes. Despondent and in tears, Barrington starts home. On the way he encounters the Great Silver Wolf who teaches Barrington two important lessons: being furry, warm and able to hop is a gift unique to bunnies and is given for a reason, and that all the animals of the forest are his family.

Revived by this new insight Barrington returns to the homes of his new families and quietly leaves them special Christmas gifts, each one with a note that says it is free gift with no strings attached from a member of their family.

I will save the end of the story for some time when I can read the whole thing for you. But it is that message that Barrington Bunny learned from the Great Silver Wolf that I thought about as I contemplated my Thanksgiving thoughts for you. While "Barrington Bunny" is a story that takes place on Christmas Eve, the message, I think, is fitting for Thanksgiving.

What Barrington learns from the Great Silver Wolf is a message I hope we can all remember at Thanksgiving. First, we have all been given gifts from God. We may not always recognize those gifts as useful, but they are given to us nonetheless. And those gifts are given to us for a reason. Second, all the animals of the forest are members of our family. We don't all look alike, or act alike, or think alike. And each of us has been given different abilities. Yet each of us is a part of the same family — children of God. And it is for the benefit of these family members that our gifts are to be used.

So, as you gather around the table at Thanksgiving, remember that you have been blessed by God with the gifts that make you who you are. And know that you are not alone, but that all the animals of the forest are your family.
