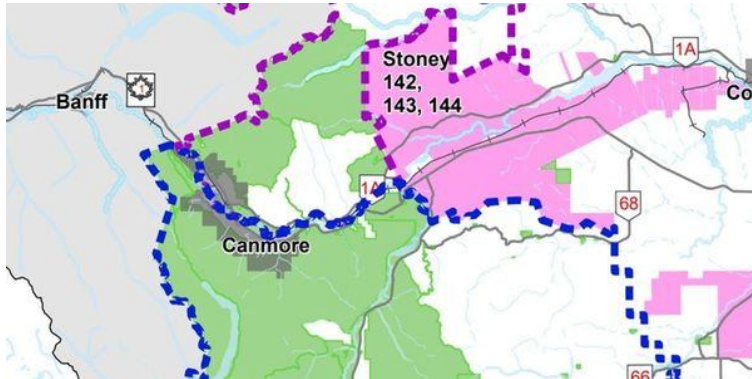


Bow Valley, Kananaskis, Bragg Creek, Ghost Survey

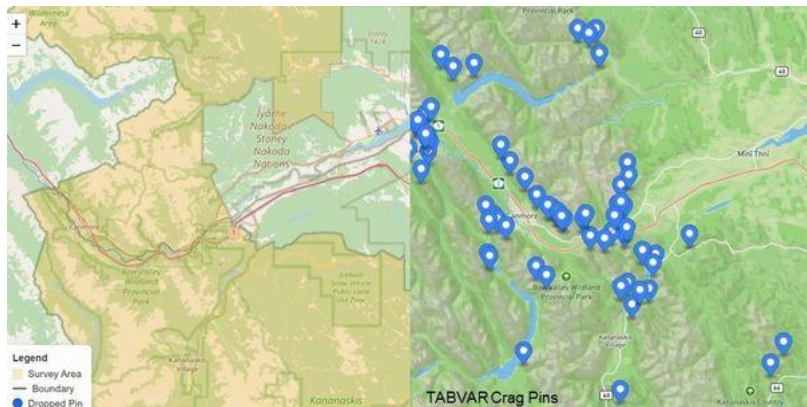
The Government of Alberta is seeking user input for the Ghost-Kananaskis sub-regional planning area [here](#):

Take the survey and pin the map with every crag you visit, know of, or even think might exist (maps for reference below). Express your concern for maintaining recreational access. The land area in question covers every crag in the Bow Valley, Bragg Creek, Kananaskis and Ghost regions.

Survey Notes

The survey scope, language and how data will be used is ambiguous. Definitions are not provided for “the natural resource economy of the area is sustained” or “human footprint is effectively managed...” and there is no mention of maintaining or improving access. In light of trail closures announced in the Canmore Area Trail Strategy Master Plan, it is critical that climbers make their use areas known and voice their concerns in hopes of preventing loss of access.
