

Resolut: A Compliance Status Infrastructure

The architecture for continuously trusted regulatory relationships

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Executive Summary

For decades, organisations have attempted to demonstrate compliance by collecting increasing volumes of evidence. Certificates, policies, audit reports, supplier questionnaires, employee credentials and software attestations are copied, stored, exchanged and repeatedly verified by every organisation in every supply chain.

This approach has become increasingly expensive, fragmented and difficult to trust.

As organisations become more interconnected, compliance is no longer confined within organisational boundaries. Every organisation depends on thousands of external relationships including employees, contingent workers, suppliers, software providers, regulators, certification bodies and customers. Each relationship introduces obligations that influence operational resilience, regulatory compliance and business continuity.

Resolut has been designed as a new category of infrastructure.

Rather than storing duplicate compliance evidence, Resolut enables trusted participants to continuously maintain and share their current compliance status, allowing every authorised relationship to verify trust directly from its source.

The result is a continuously updated trust infrastructure capable of supporting modern regulatory ecosystems.

1. The Challenge

Every organisation depends upon relationships.

Employees.

Contractors.

Temporary workers.

Professional advisers.

Suppliers.

Subcontractors.

Cloud providers.

Software vendors.

Products.

Certification bodies.

Auditors.

Regulators.

Each relationship carries obligations.

Every obligation requires evidence.

Every organisation repeatedly requests the same information from the same parties.

This duplication creates unnecessary cost while reducing confidence that information remains current.

The larger the organisation becomes, the greater the complexity.

Modern enterprises often manage:

- tens of thousands of employees
- thousands of suppliers
- hundreds of software products
- multiple regulatory frameworks
- international subsidiaries
- interconnected supply chains extending several tiers beyond direct suppliers

Traditional compliance platforms manage documentation.

Resolut manages trusted compliance relationships.

2. From Evidence Management to Compliance Status

Historically compliance has been based upon evidence.

Organisations collect documents.

Store documents.

Review documents.

Repeat.

The challenge is that evidence begins ageing immediately after it is created.

A certificate may remain valid.

The organisation may not.

A supplier may become sanctioned.

An employee licence may expire.

Software may become vulnerable.

Traditional evidence remains unchanged.

Reality changes continuously.

Resolut therefore shifts the focus from evidence to continuously validated compliance status.

Rather than asking:

"Can I see your certificate?"

Resolut answers:

"Is this relationship currently compliant?"

3. A New Infrastructure Layer

Resolut introduces a shared infrastructure connecting trusted participants rather than isolated compliance databases.

Every participant maintains responsibility for their own compliance information.

People maintain personal credentials.

Organisations maintain organisational compliance.

Suppliers maintain supplier status.

Software publishers maintain software attestations.

Certification bodies maintain accreditation.

Auditors publish assurance outcomes.

Regulators publish regulatory requirements.

Rather than copying information throughout the supply chain, authorised participants verify trusted status directly from the originating source.

Ownership remains where responsibility belongs.

4. The Compliance Relationship Model

Resolut models compliance as a network of trusted relationships rather than isolated records.

Every node represents an entity.

For example:

- Individual
- Organisation

- Supplier
- Software Product
- Physical Product
- Device
- Asset
- Process
- Certification Body
- Regulator

Relationships connect these entities.

Examples include:

- Employee works for Organisation.
- Supplier provides Products.
- Software supports Process.
- Auditor certifies Organisation.
- Regulator governs Industry.
- Every relationship may carry compliance obligations.
- Every obligation contributes towards organisational resilience.

5. Continuous Validation

Unlike traditional audit cycles, compliance status should never become static.

Resolut continuously validates authorised information from its trusted source.

Examples include:

- Professional registrations
- Insurance validity
- Training certification
- ISO certification
- Cyber security attestations
- Software Bill of Materials (SBOM)
- Supplier accreditation
- Regulatory enforcement
- Policy acceptance
- Business continuity capability

Where supported, changes are reflected immediately throughout authorised relationships.

This creates a living view of organisational compliance.

6. Relationship Intelligence

Traditional platforms measure individual compliance objects.

Resolut measures the health of the entire relationship network.

This enables organisations to understand:

- Which suppliers create the highest concentration of risk.
- Which software components affect critical services.
- Which contractors support regulated activities.
- Which certifications support operational resilience.
- Which compliance failures may cascade through multiple dependent organisations.

Relationship intelligence transforms isolated compliance records into organisational insight.

7. Supporting Multiple Regulatory Domains

Resolut has not been designed around a single regulation.

Instead, it provides infrastructure capable of supporting multiple regulatory environments simultaneously.

Examples include:

- Information Security
- Data Protection
- Operational Resilience
- Business Continuity
- Health & Safety
- Financial Services
- Healthcare
- Critical Infrastructure
- Supply Chain Assurance
- Environmental Compliance

Industry-specific obligations may be layered onto the same trusted infrastructure without redesigning the underlying platform.

8. Platform Components

Resolut consists of connected platform services.

Resolut Solo

Personal compliance ownership.

Individuals securely manage and share their verified compliance status.

Resolut Pro

Organisation-wide compliance visibility.

Supports employees, suppliers, contractors, software, products and operational relationships.

Resolut Enterprise

Multi-organisation governance across corporate groups and international subsidiaries.

Resolut Network

Shared trust across supply chains and business ecosystems.

Resolut Audit

Independent assurance and audit execution.

Resolut Conform

Certification body and accreditation management.

Resolut Regulate

Regulatory oversight and framework management.

Together these services create a unified compliance infrastructure rather than disconnected compliance applications.

9. Benefits

Organisations adopting Compliance Status Infrastructure can expect to reduce duplication while increasing confidence.

Benefits include:

- Reduced evidence collection
- Continuous compliance visibility
- Improved supply chain transparency
- Enhanced operational resilience
