

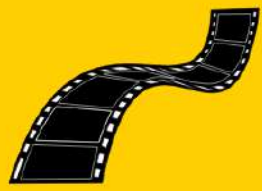

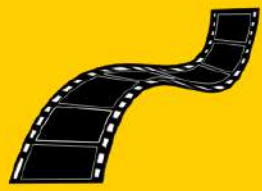


### 5. Communication Ka Safar:

This film brings up the importance of the Cleanliness workers who cleans our surroundings and makes it healthier to live in but we don't even respect their work and make them neglected from the society.



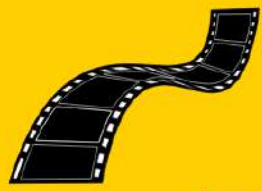
#### 10. Pranika My Sister

### 15. James Bond:

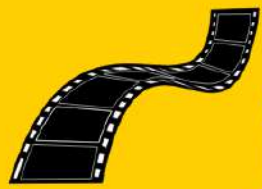
This Film beautifully displays that how the modern day devices keep a track of our web searches and online browsing and then uses this data to manipulate our expenses.

### 19. Jokhon Amra Keu Noi (When We Are Nobody):

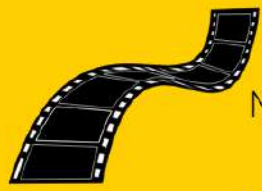

### 23. A Good Ending:

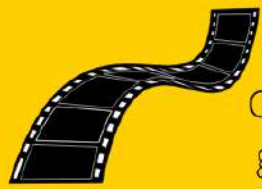

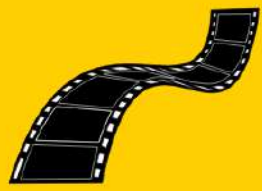


### 32. A Drop in the Ocean

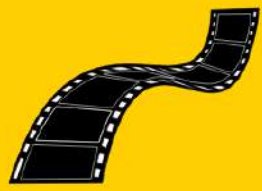
### 36. What Patriotism means to me
