

Red Sox drop series to San Fran

The Red Sox dropped two of three to division rival San Francisco. The fans filled the ball park for the three-game series setting records for a regular season series. Game one was a drubbing by the San Francisco offense 10-5 led by Luis Arraez, Jose Ramirez and Ketel Marte. Ketel Marte homered

and hit homeruns in all three games from each side of the plate during the series. Game 2 was the closest game in the series and another comeback victory for the Red Sox. Coach Goodrich called on Ryan Walker to put out the fire as Ceddanne approached the plate. He was just looking to put the ball in play to keep the inning going. He worked the count to

2-2 and then blasted a three-run double to right to put the Sox in the lead 6-4. Mason Miller finished up for his second save, Game 3 was another 10-2 drubbing as Ketel Marte hit another homerun. He was 3 for 11 in the series with three homeruns and six Rbi's. Luis Arraez went 6 for 12 in the series as well. The Sox will go back on the road to Chicago for a series with the Cubs,
