# The Yvonne H. Oliver Scholarship Application Offered by The Point Is

### Purpose of the Scholarship:

"The Point Is" is a local non-profit made up of 35 women who raise money to fund underserved women in our community. This scholarship is to honor the mother of a founding member of The Point Is, Yvonne H. Oliver, by providing funding for further education to a young lady who has shown an active commitment to her community through her service.

#### **Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must be a female senior.
- 2. Applicant must complete and submit The Point Is scholarship application.
- 3. Applicant must be accepted by or enrolled in a college or post-secondary institution at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- 4. Applicant must have taken the SAT or ACT or Placement test if offered.
- 5. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 6. Applicant must be a student at St. John's High School, James Island Charter High School, First Baptist Church School, Charleston Collegiate School, West Ashley High School, or Home Schooled.
- 7. Applicant must reside on James Island, Johns Island, or Wadmalaw Island.
- 8. Applicant must show evidence of community involvement or service.
- Applicant must submit application and all accompanying documentation by April 25, 2025.

#### Criteria:

The selection committee will give strong consideration to the candidate who is actively involved in one or more local non-profit organizations by performing service, providing expertise, or dedicating volunteer hours. The recipient will have demonstrated a commitment and contribution to the non-profit organization and will provide documentation of her activity.

Only complete applications will be considered by the committee.

#### Award:

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded by May 30th. The payment will be made to the recipient when The Point receives documentation of enrollment at a college or post-secondary institution. Funds will be given directly to the individual and may be used for any education-related expense – not solely tuition – at the June 11th meeting on John's Island.
