Flu Vaccine: To be received yearly (Flu seasons last from October to the following February/March)

***MMR:** If travelling abroad, this vaccine can be administered before age 1 year.

***Adacel-Tdap:** This vaccine covers the recipient for 5 years.

***Gardasil (HPV):** This two-dose vaccine must be administered 6 months apart if the patient is less than 15 years old during their first injection. If the patient is greater than 15 years old, a third dose must be administered.
