



32 **WHEREAS**, it is desirable to declare that Vernon County is a Second Amendment  
33 Preservation County, as Vernon County opposes the enactment of any executive order or  
34 legislation that would infringe upon the constitutional right of the people of Vernon County to  
35 keep and bear arms.

36  
37 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Vernon County Board of Supervisors  
38 hereby declares Vernon County to be a Second Amendment Preservation County, and  
39 hereby states its opposition to the enactment of any executive order or legislation that which  
40 would abolish, diminish, or in any way infringe upon the Second Amendment rights of  
41 citizens, which if implemented would ban or impose additional regulations regarding the  
42 possession of and use of any firearms, firearm accessories, magazines, or ammunition.

43  
44 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Vernon County Board hereby states its opposition to the  
45 enactment of any executive order or legislative action under consideration which would  
46 implement any firearms or confiscation or “buy back” laws, implement any new  
47 background checks or firearms owner I.D requirements, or cause the establishment of a  
48 punitive tax on the purchase or possession of firearms, firearm accessories, magazines  
49 and ammunition.

51 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Vernon County Board opposes any executive order or  
52 legislative action under consideration which would implement any type of “red flag laws”  
53 which would abolish, diminish, or in any way infringe upon the full legal rights of due  
54 process, as guaranteed to all citizens.
