



# Child Care Centers, Family Day Care Providers, Preschools & Head Start



#### **Choosing Childcare**

Choosing the right child care program for your child is an important task. There are many choices for parents and guardians and the process of making that decision can be involved. The choices include family day care, center based childcare and parent co-ops. These various providers may be large or small, profit or non-profit.

As each childcare program is different so is each family seeking childcare. When choosing a childcare program, each family should consider their individual needs. A visit to several childcare programs can help in the decision-making process. Be sure to ask a variety of questions at each visit and follow-up each discussion with additional questions. A good fit can help build a strong foundation for your child. Please note that there are many licensed center-based child care providers in the Mid-Cape region offering child care for infants, preschoolers and school-age children. For a complete list please call the Child Care Network at 508-778-9470.

Some questions to keep in mind when choosing your daycare provider include:

- Hours of operation
- Policy for Holidays/Vacation
- Food/Meals Provided
- Nap time policies
- · Schedule of the activities
- How the center or provider will communicate with the parents or guardians.
- Safety and Medical Policies
- Cost and Payment Policies

Many times, two visits to a site can help with the transition to childcare. The first visit can be the parent or guardian alone. This will offer a chance for a more relaxed atmosphere in which to observe the center. The second visit should include the child in order to acquaint him/her with their new surroundings.

While your child is attending a program be sure to communicate with your provider regularly. Be sure to let them know how your child is doing at home and how they are transitioning to their new program. If you have any questions or concerns be sure to address them sooner than later. Your childcare provider wants to be aware of any concerns you may have. Also, be sure to praise your child-care providers, it is always a good feeling to know when you are doing a great job!

#### Play Dough Recipe

1 cup flour
1 Tbsp cream of tartar
1/2 cup salt
1 cup water

2Tbsp oil food coloring

Mix all ingredients together, and cook over medium heat, stirring constantly. When the dough forms and pulls away from the sides of the pan and is no longer "shiny", remove from heat. Knead the dough until it's smooth. Add different herbs, baking scents (vanilla, peppermint,

coconut), spices, sand or cornmeal for texture, different things for the children to "build" with or create sculptures with.
