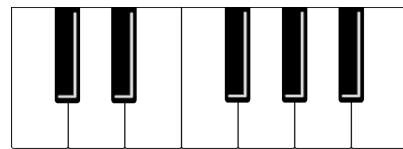
Students do not stay the whole time, but simply come for about 20 minutes any time within 4:00-6:00 p.m.
