"My church – Clairmont Presbyterian - has been a community partner of Toco Hills Community Alliance (THCA) for years. I first became involved with THCA when I took nursing students to volunteer there. I was so impressed by the services provided at THCA, their organization, and the effectiveness of how they used their resources. About the time that I retired from teaching, my church was looking for a volunteer to serve as a liaison between the church and THCA and serve on the THCA Board of Directors. I'm now in my second year on the Board and am a sustaining donor. I also volunteer in the THCA Clothes Closet. It's important to me to help people in need in my community and helping fight food insecurity is a major way to make a positive impact.

Azalea Village is a mission of my church which offers free transitional housing for immigrants and refugees. When an Afghan family fled Kabul in August of 2021 with only the clothes on their back – THCA provided food and clothing for them. **The impact this had for this family was immeasurable.**

I have seen services at THCA transform to meet the needs of the population during the pandemic when so many needed food because they had lost their jobs. **Now it's more that families struggle and need food due to inflation and not being able to afford what their families need.** My church is now a designated food distribution site for the Atlanta Community Food Bank (ACFB) and the families that have children in our LaAmistad afterschool program have been able to get food from THCA. -Elaine Taylor
