side door as people drive through or walk through. We are not serving hot lunch and the clothing closet is closed.

All volunteers wash their hands immediately upon reporting for duty, have their temperatures taken, and are required to wear gloves. All surfaces are disinfected several times daily. We are all keeping physical distance and washing our hands many, many times throughout the day. These are just a few of the changes we have incorporated and every day, we are adjusting so as to keep up with latest CDC and WHO guidelines.

Because we are providing food services to those in need, we are considered an essential service by Dekalb county, Georgia Emergency Management Agency, and the US Department of Homeland Security, so as long as we have food and volunteers (but less than 10 volunteers at a time!), we will be distributing food because the need is great. And it is easier to keep going because we have your support!
