TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Canadian Scottish Regimental Association Bursary Award

ANNUAL AWARD

1. The Canadian Scottish Regimental Association must receive applications by the end of October of each year. There will be up to three \$1000.00 bursaries awarded to serving Regimental members who qualify.

CONDITIONS FOR THE AWARD

- 2. The member chosen must be a serving member in good standing within the Regimental Family.
- 3. The criteria that will form the basis for this award are as follows:
 - a) Be of good character with no disciplinary problems.
 - b) Have made a positive contribution to the Regiment, and a Senior Cadet, that has made a positive contribution to his/her cadet corp.
 - c) Have received good assessments on all courses.
 - d) Use the award to promote his/her post-secondary education at a BC university, regional college or technical/vocational school.
 - e) Financial consideration will be looked at.

APPLICATION

4. Applications can be downloaded on the CSR website under Association, or picked up from the BOR.

SUBMISSION DATE

5. Members must submit their applications to **The Canadian Scottish Regimental Association on or before the last day of October each year.**

AWARDS COMMITTEE

6. Members of the selection committee will include the CSRA President, the Up-Island branch CSRA President, plus one member from Victoria, and one member from the Up-Island branch, and the Honorary Colonel, will assess the applicants for the bursary and make the final selection.
