Exterior:

Great curb appeal is imperative for first impressions:

- Mow the lawn.
- Mulch and weed the flower beds.
- Trim the hedges.
- Power wash the driveway & moss treat the roof.
- Clean the windows and siding.
- Keep cars out of the driveway.
- Remove decorative yard art.

Interior:
