Guidelines for Nomination and Election to the Illinois Horseshoe Pitchers Hall of Fame

- Must be an ILSHPA member for at least 10 years.
- Must have courteous, positive minded, example of good sportsmanship, dedicated time involvement in the promotion of horseshoe pitching.
- Nominations are for 1 year only. If not elected, the person will have to be re-nominated. Re-nominations can be done simply by calling or a letter to the Chairman of the Hall of Fame Committee to consider the nominee again.
- Up to 2 inductees each year.
- Excelled as a pitcher in the state competition or noted longevity in years of pitching.
- Nomination information should be detailed as possible (Example – years of service; what office (s) held during which years; ringer percentage in local, state, national tournaments, etc.
- The above guidelines should be followed as much as possible but should not limit election to the Hall of Fame if the committee finds some unusual circumstance to warrant such action.
- Nominations must be in by July 15th each year. 4

Message From Bill Marvin

First thing is to thank each and everyone for their prayers for me and my family. We have been on quite a journey and I believe that the power of prayer has helped every step of the way. I am not quite back to full strength but am so much better today than I have been in quite awhile. My Angel, Deanna, has been with me every step of the way, doing whatever it takes to get us through. She has basically been working three jobs; taking care of me, keeping up the house and working full time, and still finding time to do extra things (like Junior Director). For some reason, God blessed me with her as my life partner.

As many of you may know, Jerry LaBrosse from Minnesota and I bet a steak dinner each year on which charter wins the most trophies at the World Tournament. (We don't count Juniors). Last year Brian Fisher from Ohio joined us, so we had to change the rules just a bit. Loser buys a steak dinner for the other two, second place buys a breakfast, while first place gets to gloat. Each charter gets to challenge (eliminate) one pitcher who is not counted in the trophy total. Naturally I challenged Alan Francis (eliminating his two trophies). I am proud to say Illinois won AGAIN this year!! 30.3% of Illinois entries took home a trophy, 25.8% for Ohio and 13.8% of Minnesota. We have now won 3 years, Ohio 1, and Minnesota 1. Thanks to all of you and I will be thinking of you when I collect!!

Congratulations to all winners at the State Tournament. Deanna kept me informed on all the activities and the results of the meeting. Moline in 2021 and I hope I can make it if not as a pitcher a spectator. It is never too early to make plans. Illinois has traditionally has the largest State Tournament, so let's keep it that way.

I have been pondering the future of the Illinois Charter. As you all are very aware, your Council is made up of volunteers, none of whom get paid for their time. I know first hand how much time it takes to do all the duties of the Secretary/Treasurer, and Deanna spends considerable hours as Junior Director. Some of your officers have been serving for a number of years. Think about how you could help, and consider being an officer.

Speaking of the future, our membership has been trending down for several years, tournament attendance is down, and some parks are digging up courts to be used for other purposes. The only way to reverse this trend is to bring others to the courts. If there isn't a club or league in your part of the country, start one. It doesn't have to be sanctioned. If you get people to play on a regular basis, they will want to be sanctioned. I challenge each of you to recruit a new member. It may be someone who has pitched in the past and just needs to be asked to come back; or it may be someone at work or a new person in your neighborhood.
