

GENERAL NOTES

1. ALL WORK SHALL CONFORM TO THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS. WORK NOT COVERED BY THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS SHALL CONFORM TO THE LATEST EDITION AND SUPPLEMENTS OF THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE AND THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION (2012 GREEN BOOK) AND CITY OF LOS ANGELES.

2. DUST SHALL BE CONTROLLED BY WATERING AND/OR DUST PALLIATIVE.

3. SANITARY FACILITIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED ON THE SITE DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD.

4. WORK HOURS ARE LIMITED FROM 7:30 AM TO 7:00 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.

5. THE GRADING PLAN WHEN APPROVED SHALL BE ON THE JOB SITE AT ALL TIMES.

6. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING AND PROTECTING UTILITIES.

7. APPROVED DRAINAGE PROVISIONS AND PROTECTIVE MEASURES MUST BE USED TO PROTECT RIVER.
8. POSITIVE DRAINAGE SHALL BE MAINTAINED AWAY FROM ALL BUILDING AND SLOPE AREAS.

9. NO PAINT, PLASTER, CEMENT, SOIL, MORTAR OR OTHER RESIDUE SHALL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER STREET OR RIVER. ALL MATERIAL AND WASTE SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE SITE.

10. CONSTRUCTION SITE MUST BE FENCED AND SECURE AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.

11. ANY CONTAMINATED SOIL ENCOUNTERED SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE PROJECT MANAGER IMMEDIATELY.

1. SPECIFICATIONS: ALL WORK SHALL CONFORM TO THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS. WORK NOT COVERED BY THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS SHALL CONFORM TO THE LATEST EDITION AND SUPPLEMENTS OF CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE.

2. UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT: BEFORE COMMENCING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN AN UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (USA) INQUIRY I.D. NUMBER BY CALLING 8-1-1. TWO WORKING DAYS SHALL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE I.D. NUMBER IS OBTAINED AND BEFORE THE CONTRACTOR STARTS THE EXCAVATION WORK SO THAT UTILITY OWNERS CAN BE NOTIFIED.

3. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO FACILITIES.

4. PLANS ARE NOT TO BE UTILIZED UNLESS STAMPED "APPROVED" BY THE ENGINEER OF RECORD.

5. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE TIMELY NOTIFICATION TO THE ENGINEER OF RECORD OF ANY POTENTIAL OR ACTUAL DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN CIVIL PLANS AND OTHER PLANS/ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS.

6. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A COMPLETE SET OF PLANS IN THE FIELD. PLANS SHALL BE MARKED UP TO REFLECT ACTUAL OR AS-BUILT CONDITIONS. PLANS SHALL BE KEPT CURRENT. CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO MAINTAIN ALL NECESSARY STANDARD PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS IN THE FIELD.

7. QUANTITIES PROVIDED HEREIN ARE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATES FOR PERMITTING OR BONDING PURPOSES ONLY AND ARE NOT TO BE USED FOR BIDDING. CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM ITS OWN CONSTRUCTION TAKEOFFS.

8. NOT ALL UTILITIES MAY BE SHOWN. CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY ELEVATIONS AND LOCATIONS OF ALL AFFECTED UTILITIES. PROTECT IN PLACE, RELOCATE, OR REPLACE AS NECESSARY. PROVIDE TEMPORARY UTILITY SERVICES AS NECESSARY.

9. ELEVATIONS INDICATED MAY HAVE BEEN INTERPOLATED FROM EXISTING TOPOGRAPHIC OR RECORD MAPS. CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY ELEVATIONS AND LOCATIONS WHERE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS JOIN EXISTING.

10. ROUGH GRADE, FINISH GRADE, AND AS-BUILT CERTIFICATIONS MAY BE NECESSARY. CERTIFICATION SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THE CONTRACTOR'S ENGINEER AND PROVIDED TO THE ENGINEER OF RECORD IF PER WCA/ANF REQUIREMENTS.

11. APPROVAL OF THESE PLANS BY THE WCA/ANF DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A REPRESENTATION AS TO THE ACCURACY OR COMPLETENESS OF THE LOCATION OR THE EXISTENCE OR NON-EXISTENCE OF ANY UTILITY AND/OR STRUCTURE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THIS PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO TAKE ALL DUE PRECAUTIONARY MEANS TO PROTECT THE UTILITIES OF RECORD OR NOT OF RECORD OR NOT SHOWN ON THESE PLANS.

12. THE GRADING CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE PRECISE GRADING QUANTITY AS SHOWN ON THIS PLAN AS PART OF HIS BID.

13. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL REQUIRED PERMITS PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF GRADING OPERATIONS.
17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY DURING THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK DONE UNDER THIS CONTRACT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE THE NECESSARY PRECAUTION TO AVOID ANY DAMAGE TO ANY STRUCTURES OR FEATURES ADJACENT TO THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PEDESTRIANS.

18. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN NECESSARY PERMITS PRIOR TO COMMENCING ANY GRADING OR EXCAVATIONS.

19. SELECTIVE REMOVALS:

19.A. REMOVE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS THAT INTERFERE WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT, AND NO MORE THAN IS INDICATED IN THE DEMOLITION PLAN;

19.B. ALL REMOVALS OR RELOCATIONS OF EXISTING UTILITIES SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE OWNER OF SAID UTILITY. NO REMOVALS OR RELOCATIONS OF EXISTING UTILITIES SHALL COMMENCE PRIOR TO APPROVAL OF SAID UTILITY.

20. REPAIR AND/OR REPLACE ANY EXISTING BROKEN OR OFF-GRADE PAVEMENT, CONCRETE CURB, GUTTER OR SIDEWALK IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO OR WITHIN THE AREA OF THIS IMPROVEMENT SATISFACTORY TO THE ANF.

21. SURVEY MONUMENT PRESERVATION IS REQUIRED AND SHALL INCLUDE SUBMITTAL OF PRE AND POST CONSTRUCTION SURVEY MONUMENT TIES TO THE ENGINEER.

22. NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS WILL BE ALLOWED TO FALL IN TO THE CATCH BASIN OR STORMDRAIN, IF ANY MATERIAL IS INADVERTENTLY INTRODUCED, THEN IT WILL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY.

23. TRENCH BACKFILL FOR ALL STORM DRAINS CONSTRUCTED IN DRAINAGE EASEMENTS SHALL BE MECHANICALLY COMPACTED TO A RELATIVE DENSITY OF 90%.

24. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO SECURE AND PAY FOR ALL NECESSARY CONSTRUCTION LAYDOWN AREAS.

25. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITIES OF RENTING OPERATING EQUIPMENTS.

26. ALL REPAIRS TO CONSTRUCTION LAYDOWN AREAS AND TEMPORARY IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE INSPECTOR AND/OR AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PROPERTY OWNER PER REQUEST.

27. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE, REGRADE AND, WHEN NECESSARY, BACKFILL TO RESTORE THE CONSTRUCTION LAY DOWN ACCESS AND TEMPORARY IMPROVEMENTS TO ITS ORIGINAL/FORMER CONDITION AT THE COMPLETION OF THE WORK.

28. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BACKFILL EXCAVATED AREAS WITH ENGINEERED FILL UP TO THE ORIGINAL GRADE, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED OR INDICATED ON THESE PLANS. BACKFILL PIPE TRENCH ACCESSSES ONLY AFTER PIPING HAS BEEN INSPECTED.

UNAUTHORIZED CHANGES AND USES: THE ENGINEER PREPARING THESE PLANS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR LIABLE FOR, UNAUTHORIZED CHANGES TO OR USES OF THESE PLANS. ALL CHANGES TO THE PLANS MUST BE IN WRITING AND MUST BE APPROVED BY THE PREPARER OF THESE PLANS AND THE WCA/ANF.

14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL DIMENSION AND CONDITIONS IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO STARTING ANY WORK.
15. THE ENGINEER DOES NOT WARRANT THE ACCURACY OF SCALED DIMENSION ON ANY PLAN. ALL DIMENSIONS SHALL BE AS DESIGNATED ON THE PLAN.

2. IT IS THE GRADING CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REVIEW THE GRADING PLANS AND SOILS REPORT THOROUGHLY PRIOR TO SITE MOBILIZATION. IT IS ALSO THE GRADING CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY THE CIVIL AND SOILS ENGINEERS IF ONSITE DISCREPANCIES ARE OBSERVED THAT WOULD AFFECT THE EARTHWORK QUANTITIES.

3. THE EXISTING TOPOGRAPHY AS DELINEATED ON THESE DRAWINGS SHALL BE UTILIZED AS THE BASIS FOR ALL EARTHWORK COMPUTATIONS. SAID TOPOGRAPHY SHALL BE PRESUMED TO BE ACCEPTABLE TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES UNLESS A DEVIATION IS FOUND PRIOR TO THE START OF GRADING ANY SPECIFIC AREAS. ANY DEVIATION SO DETERMINED SHALL BE PROMPTLY TRANSMITTED TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES.

4. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO ESTIMATE THE QUANTITIES OF GRADING WORK TO BE DONE AND INCLUDE ALL COSTS THEREFROM IN HIS BID, AS NO ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE WILL BE MADE WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT FROM THE OWNER.
5. OVER-EXCAVATION AND/OR EXCESS BACKFILLING OR DUPLICATION OF GRADING ACTIVITIES IS NOT A BASIS FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION. THIS ALSO APPLIES WHERE MATERIAL IS TO BE REMOVED AND REPLACED TO REDUCE MOISTURE CONTENT.

6. OFF-SITE DISPOSAL OF EXCAVATION MATERIAL IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE INCLUDED IN HIS BID. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HOLD THE OWNER AND ENGINEER HARMLESS AS A RESULT OF ANY CLAIMS ARISING FROM ACTIONS ENROUTE OR AWAY FROM THE SITE. EXCAVATION MATERIALS SHALL BE DISPOSED OF AT A LEGAL LANDFILL WITH A HAUL PERMIT. NO SOIL OR DEBRIS SHALL BE DISPOSED OF ON GOVERNMENT PROPERTY WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST.

7. EARTH VOLUMES SHOWN HEREIN ARE ESTIMATES BASED UPON THE GEOTECHNICAL ANALYSIS PERFORMED BY THE NAMED SOILS ENGINEER AND TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY OF THE EXISTING GROUND SURFACE AT THE TIME OF PLAN PREPARATION. EARTHWORK VOLUMES ARE COMPUTED BY METHODS COMMONLY USED IN STANDARD ENGINEERING PRACTICE, AND ARE INTENDED FOR USE IN ESTABLISHING GOVERNING AGENCY FEES. GENERAL NOTES

1. ALL GRADING AND CONSTRUCTION SHALL CONFORM TO LATEST EDITION OF THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE UNLESS SPECIFICALLY NOTED ON THESE PLANS.

2. ANY MODIFICATIONS OF OR CHANGES TO APPROVED GRADING PLANS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEER.

3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT AN INSURANCE CERTIFICATE INDEMNIFYING AND NAMING THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED FOR ALL WORK IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

4. CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE (SECTION 5097.98) AND HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE (SECTION 7050.5) ADDRESS THE DISCOVERY AND DISPOSITION OF HUMAN REMAINS. IN THE EVENT OF DISCOVERY OR RECOGNITION OF ANY HUMAN REMAINS IN ANY LOCATION OTHER THAN A DEDICATED CEMETERY, THE LAW REQUIRES THAT GRADING IMMEDIATELY STOPS AND NO FURTHER EXCAVATION OR DISTURBANCE OF THE SITE, OR ANY NEARBY AREA WHERE HUMAN REMAINS MAY BE LOCATED, OCCUR UNTIL THE FOLLOWING HAS MEASURES HAVE BEEN TAKEN:

4.A. THE COUNTY CORONER HAS BEEN INFORMED AND HAS DETERMINED THAT NO INVESTIGATION OF THE CAUSE OF DEATH IS REQUIRED, AND

4.B. IF THE REMAINS ARE OF NATIVE AMERICAN ORIGIN, THE DESCENDANTS FROM THE DECEASED NATIVE AMERICANS HAVE MADE A RECOMMENDATION FOR THE MEANS OF TREATING OR DISPOSING, WITH APPROPRIATE DIGNITY, OF THE HUMAN REMAINS AND ANY ASSOCIATED GRAVE GOODS.

5. THE LOCATION AND PROTECTION OF ALL UTILITIES IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERMITTEE.

6. SLOPES SHALL BE A MAXIMUM 3:1, UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED AND CERTIFIED BY THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER.

7. ALL GRADES BETWEEN CONTOURS AND/OR SPOT ELEVATIONS SHALL BE ASSUMED TO BE STRAIGHT GRADES. THERE SHALL BE NO LOCALIZED DEPRESSIONS OR HUMPS.

8. TRENCHES AND SLOPES WITH A VERTICAL HEIGHT GREATER THAN 4 FT SHALL BE PROPERLY PROTECTED PER OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA) STANDARDS.

9. ALL EXPORT MATERIAL FROM THE SITE SHALL BE HAULED TO A LEGAL LANDFILL. A COPY OF THE LANDFILL RECEIPT SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE INSPECTOR UPON REQUEST.

10. A COPY OF THE GRADING PERMIT AND APPROVED GRADING PLANS SHALL BE AVAILABLE AT THE SITE AT ALL TIMES.

11. PRIOR TO GRADING, SITE BOUNDARIES, EASEMENTS, DRAINAGE DEVICES, AND RESTRICTED USE AREAS SHALL BE LOCATED PER CONSTRUCTION STAKING BY THE CIVIL ENGINEER OR LICENSED SURVEYOR.

12. AN EROSION CONTROL PLAN, TO BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE ANF, IS REQUIRED FOR ALL GRADING PERMITS.

13. TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY: IF THE CIVIL ENGINEER, THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER, OR THE ENGINEERING GEOLOGIST OF RECORD IS CHANGED DURING GRADING, ALL GRADING ACTIVITIES SHALL STOP UNTIL THE REPLACEMENT AGREES IN WRITING TO ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY WITHIN THE AREA OF TECHNICAL COMPETENCE FOR APPROVAL UPON COMPLETION OF WORK. THE PERMITTEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO NOTIFY THE CITY ENGINEER IN WRITING OF SUCH CHANGE PRIOR TO RECOMMENCING ANY GRADING.

INSPECTION NOTES

1. THE PERMITTEE OR HIS AGENT SHALL NOTIFY THE WCA/ANF AT LEAST TWO WORKING DAYS IN ADVANCE OF REQUIRED INSPECTIONS AT THE FOLLOWING STAGES OF WORK.

2. 18A. PRE-GRADE - BEFORE THE START OF ANY EARTH DISTURBING ACTIVITY OR CONSTRUCTION.

3. 18B. INITIAL - WHEN THE SITE HAS BEEN CLEARED OF VEGETATION AND UNAPPROVED FILL HAS BEEN MITIGATED PER THE APPROVED GEOTECHNICAL REPORT. FILL SHALL NOT BE PLACED PRIOR TO THIS INSPECTION. PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING GRADING, ALL STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION MEASURES SHALL BE INSTALLED.

4. 18C. ROUGH - WHEN APPROXIMATE FINAL ELEVATIONS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED; DRAINAGE TERRACES, SWALES AND BERMS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED AT THE TOP OF THE SLOPE; AND ROUGH GRADING HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEER AND THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER.

5. 18D. FINAL - WHEN GRADING HAS BEEN COMPLETED; ALL DRAINAGE DEVICES INSTALLED; SLOPE PLANTING ESTABLISHED; IRRIGATION SYSTEMS INSTALLED; AS-BUILT PLANS SUBMITTED AND APPROVED; AND FINAL GRADING HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEER AND GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER.

6. ALL GRADED SITES MUST HAVE DRAINAGE SWALES, BERMS, AND OTHER DRAINAGE DEVICES INSTALLED PRIOR TO ROUGH GRADING APPROVAL.

7. THE CIVIL ENGINEER AND GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER SHALL CERTIFY THE ROUGH GRADING AND FINAL GRADING PRIOR TO EACH RESPECTIVE INSPECTION.

8. FINAL GRADING MUST BE APPROVED BEFORE OCCUPANCY OF BUILDING WILL BE ALLOWED.

DRAINAGE NOTES

9. DRAINAGE ACROSS PROPERTY LINES SHALL NOT EXCEED THAT WHICH EXISTED PRIOR TO GRADING OR CONSTRUCTION. EXCESS OR CONCENTRATED DRAINAGE SHALL BE CONTAINED ON SITE OR DIRECTED TO AN APPROVED DRAINAGE FACILITY.

10. ROOF DRAINAGE MUST BE DIVERTED FROM GRADED SLOPES.

11. PROVISIONS SHALL BE MADE FOR CONTRIBUTORY DRAINAGE AT ALL TIMES.

12. A 2 PERCENT MINIMUM DRAINAGE SLOPE AWAY FROM PROPOSED STRUCTURES AND PROPERTY LINES SHALL BE PROVIDED.

13. DRAINAGE SWALES SHALL HAVE A 1 PERCENT MINIMUM DRAINAGE SLOPE.

15. THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER SHALL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT INSPECTIONS DURING THE PREPARATION OF THE NATURAL GROUND AND THE PLACEMENT AND COMPACTION OF THE FILL TO CERTIFY THE WORK IS BEING PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED GRADING PLANS AND REPORTS.

16. THE GROUND SURFACE SHALL BE PREPARED TO RECEIVE FILL BY REMOVING VEGETATION, TOPSOIL, AND OTHER UNSUITABLE MATERIALS. EXCEPT FOR EXISTING TREES AND VEGETATION TO REMAIN, AND SCARIFYING THE GROUND TO PROVIDE A BOND WITH THE FILL MATERIAL. PROTECT REMAINING TREES DURING ALL OF CONSTRUCTION.

17. ALL FILL MATERIAL SHALL BE COMPACTED TO 90 PERCENT OF MAXIMUM DENSITY AS DETERMINED BY ASTM D 1557, MODIFIED PROCTOR, IN LIFTS AS RECOMMENDED IN THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER'S REPORT, NOT TO EXCEED 8 INCHES IN DEPTH. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ALL SOIL COMPACTION TESTS. SOILS COMPACTION TEST LOCATIONS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE SOILS ENGINEER AND THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS.

18. ROCK(S) OR SIMILAR MATERIAL(S) GREATER THAN 8 INCHES IN DIAMETER SHALL NOT BE PLACED IN THE FILL UNLESS APPROVED BY THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER.

PLANTING AND IRRIGATION NOTES

19. PLANTING AND IRRIGATION ON GRADED SLOPES SHALL BE INSTALLED TO PREVENT EROSION. THE PLANTING AND IRRIGATION SYSTEMS SHALL BE INSTALLED AS SOON AS PRACTICAL AFTER ROUGH GRADING. ALL SLOPE PLANTING MUST BE WELL ESTABLISHED PRIOR TO FINAL GRADING APPROVAL.

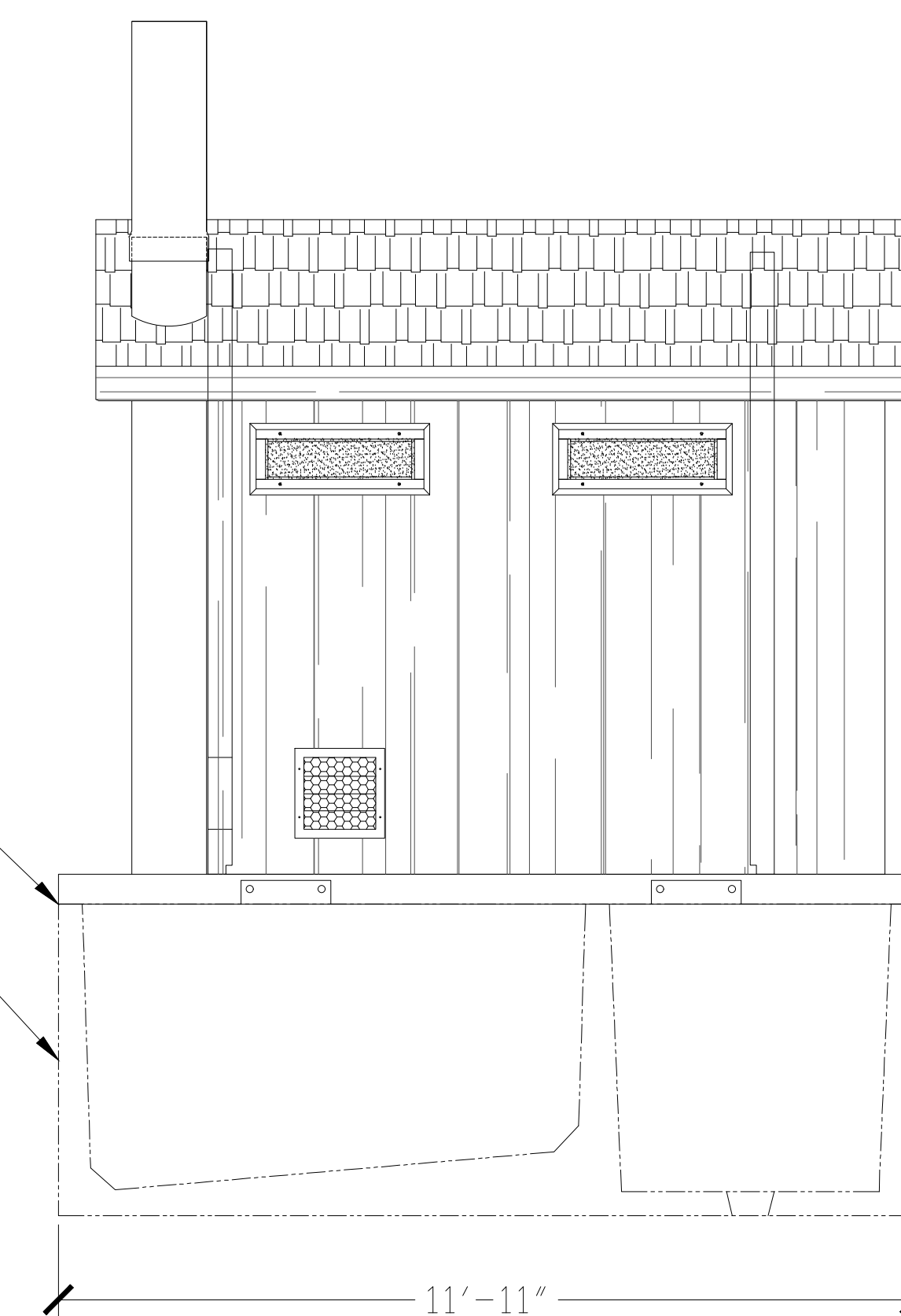
