

- 01 The HARBOR DEPARTMENT of the CITY OF LOS ANGELES, California, invites electronic bids in accordance with Specification No. 2846 for WILMINGTON WATERFRONT PARK WEST END RESTROOM AND SITE RESTORATION.
- 02 Project consists of construction of restroom building with utility connections and shade structures. Work includes but is not limited to replanting of tree groves, irrigation, demolition of existing non-functioning fountain, site repairs, site utility removals, landscaping, and replacement of damaged site furnishings.
- 03 Contract Documents are available in Department's Web-based Bid Management System called "Construction Division Business Opportunity Network (CDBON)" utilizing an online bid management system at <https://www.portoflosangeles.org/business/contracting-opportunities/construction-bids>. Bidders shall be required to register to download Drawings, Specifications, Addenda, and other important documents. A plan holders list can be accessed without registering. For information concerning bids, call Department at (310) 732-3522.
- 04 A virtual pre-bid conference shall be held on April 29, 2026 at 9 a.m. via Microsoft Teams. Please RSVP to Marlys White if you plan to attend. The agenda and related materials shall be posted to CDBON and shall be discussed in detail at the meeting.
- 05 Bids must be submitted online via Port of Los Angeles CDBON system on or before 2:45:00 p.m. (PST/PDT) on June 17 3, 2026 at which time, bid results shall be available for viewing.
- 06 Each bid must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the following: a check certified by a responsible financial institution, or a cashier's check issued by a responsible financial institution, or by a satisfactory bid bond, payable to the order of City of Los Angeles Harbor Department, for an amount not less than 10 percent of the aggregate sum of the bid, as a guarantee that Bidder shall enter into Contract if awarded, and furnish the required bonds. Bid bond shall be placed with insurance carriers which are rated VII, A- or better in Best's Insurance Guide. If a Best's Insurance Guide rating is not available, then the proposed carrier must meet comparable standards in another rating service satisfactory to City.
- 07 The provisions of Sections 10.8 through 10.11 and 10.13 of Los Angeles Administrative Code pertaining to nondiscrimination and affirmative action shall be a part of said Contract. Portions of these provisions are summarized in Subsections 00030.03 and 00030.04 of BIDDING DOCUMENTS Section which set forth requirements Bidder must acknowledge.
