| Please provide the manufacturer, system model, and as-built drawings of the fire sprinkler and fire alarm | PD does not have an existing fire alarm system. PD has fire hoses and extinguishers for firefighting purposes. |
| Verify the accuracy of the soils report's recommendation. Please confirm if excavation to a depth of 7.5 feet is required based on actual conditions. | Up to 7.5 feet of existing fill was encountered locally during exploration. The existing fill is considered to be uncertified fill and is not suitable for support of the new slab-on-grade. All existing fill materials shall be properly removed and recompacted to a minimum of 90% of the maximum density for support of the new slab-ongrade as required by the building code. Slot cutting procedure is also provided in the soils report for excavations along the existing building. Stan Tang, Geotechnologies, Inc. |

| Please advise whether the existing police department building may be used for project team meetings and/or to house the temporary field office. | The police department does not have a dedicated space available for a temporary office. |
| Verify working hours for weekdays and weekends | Working hours are between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Weekend work is typically restricted and requires prior writen approval from the City of AHJ. |
| Please provide the Engineering Budget for this project. | The engineering budget is not being published as part of the bid documents. |

It was stated in the Pre-Bid Meeting that Fire Sprinkler work is not included; however, Division 21 in the Bid Detail Form lists a Fire Suppression item. Please clarify.

There is no fire sprinkler system included in the design documents or required as part of this project scope. The Division 21 line in the Bid Detail Form is included as a standard placeholder and should be marked "Not Applicable" or left blank in your bid submittal.
