

Applying for the Apprenticeship Fact Sheet

- You must be 18 years old to join the apprenticeship.
 - You can apply for the apprenticeship when you are 17 years old but cannot be accepted until you are 18.
- You must have a High School diploma or GED to join the apprenticeship.
- You must have two forms of legal identification, and one must have a picture.
- The apprenticeship program at the Arizona Pipe Trades Apprenticeship is a five-year, state registered, apprenticeship program in plumbing and pipefitting.
- This is an earn-while-you-learn program where you will be placed on a job, under the supervision of a qualified journeyman, as well as taking a variety of trade related classes at our Training Center.
- You do not need any prior experience, and even if you do have experience, we still prefer that most people complete the entire apprenticeship program.
- We have a great appreciation for military veterans and have a couple of preference programs in place for those that have served. Details will be shared during the application and interview process.
- This first step in the application process is to take an in-person aptitude test and you can schedule that using the link below.

 - Testing will start on October 17, 2022, and will take place throughout the day on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday throughout October and into November.
 - The test is specifically designed to find the best candidates for this trade and has personality questions, logic questions, and questions about mechanical aptitude.
 - There is no study guide for the test
