

As a prerequisite to successful recertification, an 8-hour review course must be completed.

There are two options for recertification:

- An Online Refresher Course, Fee \$350.00
- An 8-hour Instructor Led Refresher Course, Fee \$400.00
- The Online Refresher Course is a self-paced study course/practice exam, you take at your
 convenience wherever you have access to the internet. All the reference materials are included in the
 fee. Upon successful completion of the course you will register for the final proctored written and
