## P.I.P.E. MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS INSTALLERS DAY CLASS SCHEDULE FOR 2024

We will need a minimum of 10 students to conduct the class. Please register ASAP. Contractor employees need to have a City of Phoenix Journeyman License or a notarized letter on company letter head stating that the individual applying for certification has at least four (4) years of trade related experience.

NFPA 99-2021 *Standard for Health Care Facilities* is covered in this class. Installers include anyone who works on or installs piping or components, in healthcare facilities including dental offices. The purpose of this class is to provide the minimum performance criteria, for Medical Gas Systems Installers to assure compliance with ASSE Standard 6010.

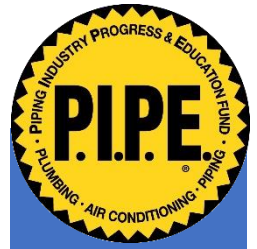
