4:10 Grant Review

- West Marin Fund Organizational Effectiveness grant due Saturday. We are applying for infrastructural support, Stewards are also applying.
 - Invitation only childhood equity grant

4:13 Budgets-projected 2026 budget

- Cleaning up the chart of accounts. Changes such as 5% to 10% fiscal sponsorship contribution.

4:17 Preschool update from Alyssa: Second meeting of the “preschool committee” tonight

- Talk of applying applying for West Marin Collaborative Grant
- Goal of preschool committee is to Design a Model Program for Communities of Bolinas/Stinson to have equitable access to preschool/childcare for 0-3 years old.
 - Is this goal of 0-3 in line with the needs of the community?
- New nonprofit? Focused on 0-5 year olds. Bolinas is largest community but least served and most isolated.
 - ORRR could we consider the 0-5 year old in the scope of the Foundation?
- Parcel Tax targeting non-resident homes. To do: Existing voting district runs parcel tax. increase (Fanny is leading research). *Leila: Lots of parcel tax increase proposals*
- Preschool good to operate as is next year (2026-2027)
- *Leila: Results from survey for needs from 0-3= nothing conclusive. Why nonprofit also including 4 and 5 year olds, when that is in clearly district jurisdiction*
- A couple of weeks ago there was a community meeting.
- Needs for the forest school, how can we support them? Proposal to do a feasibility study on a preschool with papermill. *Leila: 0-5 is supportive of the private school model this is a buffer against boom and bust cycle of attendance–need clarity NOT competition between schools: 0-3 feeds into public school.*
- Forest school looking for new location? Euphorbia sponsorship?
- Omar strong opinion that 3 year olds should be with 4 year olds, but there are contrary feelings.
- Marin Community Foundation pulled scholarships from papermill a few months ago.
- Current \$627000 parcel tax how is it currently allocated? If there is any money left, there is no reason it shouldn't be able to cover preschool. Increases by 3% each year.

4:42 Grant Writing:

- Currently: 72 / 119 kids in enrichment programs (not including Earth Allies/Stewards). 39/72 applied for scholarships. Other ideas: Biking, Archery, Mechanics

4:45 After school Programming HELP. Currently each provider is expected to send out an email, rather than a coagulation of all. Host on our website, have parents sign up on our website. Leah running living room and has no capacity to do admin. Our roles: Cultivate new programming, post schedules and links to registration through the district. Need scholarship
