Not 10 seconds later he sees the moped bearing down on him again.

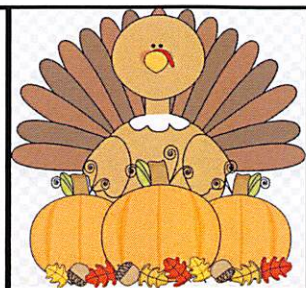
The Ferrari is flat out and there's nothing he can do!

Notice 25S89—for 2015 to 2019 Ford vehicles. The rear view camera could display a blank or distorted image on the center display screen when the vehicle is in reverse. Or you could receive a message that the rear view camera is unavailable on the center screen.

Parts are NOT available to fix this issue at this time. You will receive a notification via mail when the parts become available.

Notice 25S92—for 2015 to 2017 Ford vehicles. Exposure to a corrosive environment (road salt for example) may weaken your vehicle's driver and / or passenger front seatbelt anchor or result in separation from the assemblies.

Parts are NOT available to fix this issue. You will receive a notification via mail when the parts become available.

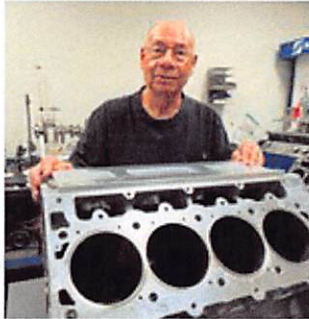

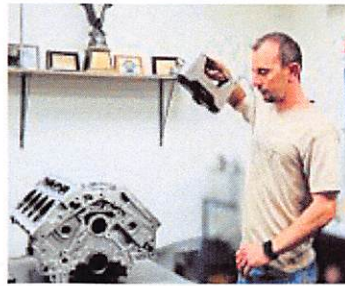
