

MINISTERS DELINQUENT DUES POLICY

LAST UPDATED: March 9, 2020, Colorado District Board

The District Secretary-Treasurer will send a certified letter to any licensed minister that is more than two months delinquent on his or her district ministerial dues/tithes. This correspondence will give thirty days to get caught up. Arrangements for repayment must be made with his or her Presbyter and District Superintendent/Secretary, or their license will be dropped.

The District Secretary-Treasurer will make available the contribution reports to all ministers requiring their signature, to be returned to the District Secretary/Treasurer prior to the start of District Conference in order to vote.
