BOARD MEETING

May 22, 2026

The Scott County 911 Emergency Services Board held their meeting at 1:00 p.m. on May 22, 2026, via Zoom with the following members present: Larry Chasteen Chairperson, Wes Drury, Billy Sullivan, Shawn Jackson, William Watson, Ken Dicus, Angela Rodgers, Director and Miranda Chambers, Secretary.

The following guests were present: Cindy Driden, and Ryan Smith.

Larry Chasteen, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Due to the meeting being an emergency meeting, there was no agenda present.

There were no minutes to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS

The Motorola quote for the combination for the project. They were unable to make a combined contract. We are trying to make the switch from Callworkds to Vesta. The price of Vesta would be \$174,000 a year to cover the cost of 9 telephone systems for the centers. The proposed Motorola lease would be \$172,516 a year to cover the cost of 9 consoles for the centers, this cost includes buying out the current Scott County contract that the board covers the cost of, which is \$108,000 a year. The contract would be for 10 years with a 2-year deferred payment.

A motion was made by Shawn Jackson to move forward with the contract and also pay \$500,000 up front to help reduce yearly costs. A role call vote was called, and the results are as follows:

The motion passed unanimously.
