RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SALTCOATS NO. 213

BYLAW NO. 7/2010

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SALTCOATS NO. 213

The Council of the R.M. of Saltcoats No. 213, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - "Road" means any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Saltcoats No. 213 other than:
 - (i) a private road:
 - (ii) a provincial highway.
- 2. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 46 meters (150 feet) from the centerline of any road.
- 3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 92 meters (300 feet) from a road intersection centerline.
- 4. Notwithstanding section 2 of this bylaw, Council at its discretion may permit, due to existing physical circumstances peculiar to the site and upon application to council, a building to locate closer to the centerline of a road.
- 5. This bylaw does not apply with respect to buildings situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
- 6. Bylaw No. 11-86 is hereby repealed.
- Any person guilty of any infraction to any provisions of this bylaw shall upon ø. summary conviction, be liable to a fine as per the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
