### What is HPV?

- HPV is a very common virus
- There are over 150 types of HPV
- Both men and women can be infected

# What is HPV? (Booklet pg. 1)

- In most cases your body will kill the virus
- If HPV stays in your body it can cause major health issues
- HPV can cause other health problems, including:
  - Cancer
  - Genital Warts


Normal cell

HPV damages cell

Cancer or genital warts

# HPV and Cancer (Booklet pg. 1)

- There is <u>no</u> way to know who will get an HPV related cancer
- Throat cancer is most common in men
- Cervical cancer is most common in women



### HPV and Genital Warts (Booklet pg.2)

- Both men and women can get genital warts
- What are genital warts?
  - Small bumps in the genital area
  - Appearance:
    - Small or large
    - Tall or flat
    - Shaped like cauliflower
- ☐ If you think you have them, tell your doctor!

# How is HPV spread? (Booklet pg. 3)

- □ Intimate skin-to-skin contact
- Intercourse is the main way HPV is spread
- Where do I <u>not</u> get the virus from?



People can spread HPV even if they do not have symptoms

Most people with HPV never develop symptoms

People who get infected often find out too <u>late</u> that they have HPV

# What does too late mean? When you get diagnosed with cancer.

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# What can I do to protect myself? (Booklet pg. 4)

#### Practice safe sex:

- Use condoms:
  - They do not completely protect you
  - They do minimize your risk for getting HPV

### Ask your doctor about regular screenings:

■ It is easier for women to get screened than men



# HPV VACCINE IS CANCER PREVENTION

### Let's talk about the HPV Vaccine! (Booklet pg. 5)

### Who should get the HPV vaccine?

- Boys and girls who are 11 or 12 years of age or older.
- Men and women through age 26.



# Let's talk about the HPV Vaccine! (Booklet pg. 6)

### How many doses of the vaccine will I need?

- If you get your first dose <u>before</u> your <u>15<sup>th</sup> birthday</u>, you will need 2 doses.
  - Second dose: 6 to 12 months after your first dose
- If you get your first dose <u>after</u> your <u>15<sup>th</sup> birthday</u>, you will need 3 doses.
  - Second dose: 1 to 2 months after your first dose
  - Third dose: 6 months after your first dose

### Let's talk about the HPV Vaccine! (Booklet pg. 7)

### Who should not get the HPV vaccine?

- Anyone who has had a severe allergic reaction to a previous dose of the vaccine.
- Anyone who has a life-threatening allergy to the vaccine to any ingredient in the vaccine.

### Let's talk about the HPV Vaccine! (Booklet pg. 10)

### Does the vaccine have side effects?

The HPV vaccine might have some side effects. Side effects that do occur are a result of your immune system working!



# Let's talk about the HPV Vaccine! (Booklet pg. 11)



### The Vaccine is:

- Very safe and effective
- Best way to <u>prevent</u> cancer!

Every year in the U.S., 27,000 people get cancer caused by HPV.



That's 1 person every 20 minutes of every day, all year long.

# Why is this important in Arkansas?

#### Arkansas ranks:

- 49<sup>th</sup> for females 13-17 who have received the HPV vaccine series correctly
- 47<sup>th</sup> for males 13-17 who have received the HPV vaccine series correctly
