- **Key Events:**

- War in Iraq and Afghanistan
- Sandy Hook School shooting, 2012
- Boston Marathon, 2013
- Hartford Consensus (document)
- **2014:** First course was created and titled “Bleeding Control Basic (B-CON)” created by Peter T. Pons, MD, FACEP and Norman E. McSwain, Jr., MD, FACS
- **2015:** The STOP THE BLEED campaign was launched by the White House
- **Key groups:** ACS, NAEMT, ACEP, CoTCCC
