- Key Events:
 - War in Iraq and Afghanistan
 - Sandy Hook School shooting, 2012
 - Boston Marathon, 2013
 - Hartford Consensus (document)
- <u>2014</u>: First course was created and titled "Bleeding Control Basic (B-CON)" created by <u>Peter T. Pons, MD,</u> <u>FACEP</u> and <u>Norman E. McSwain</u>, Jr., MD, FACS
- <u>2015</u>: The STOP THE BLEED campaign was launched by the White House
- Key groups: ACS, NAEMT, ACEP, CoTCCC
