2 How do you handle big feelings and behavior issues at camp?

We are proactive with big feelings by implementing breathing techniques, yoga, sit spots, connection conversations, and more. Mrs. Cassi is trained in Conscious Discipline and has clear expectations around acceptable and unacceptable behaviors. Children are expected to behave in a way that builds up the culture of the community of campers, while staying in alignment with who they truly are. Please communicate any and all strategies to help us help your child.

3 Do I need to pack swimwear, a towel, and rain gear every day?

Yes, this ensures that your child is prepared to play no matter where we go or what the weather is. We will be outdoors, with only a few A.C. breaks, so please prepare them with the proper supplies so they can have all the fun!

4 Are the staff that are working at camp safe?

Yes, everyone that is working with the children have been background checked and vetted for safety.

5 Is Mrs. Cassi a stickler for children's safety? What about pool safety?

Absolutely. Every choice made for the group is with the safety of all of the children in mind. Swim tests will be conducted (by our staff) at the beginning of each campers summer to insure their abilities at the pool. If they are not strong swimmers, they will be required to wear a lifejacket while at camp. You may send in a lifejacket from home to use as long as they are U.S. Coast guard approved.

6 Can my child warm up their food at camp or use the refrigerator?

No. There are not enough hours in our day to give everyone the opportunity to use the microwave and the refrigerator is too small. Please pack a lunchbox with icepacks and good insulation.

7 Can my child bring toys from home to camp? (Including Pokémon Cards)

No toys from home. We prefer to keep campers focused on using the supplies that we have at camp. We may have special Pokémon days, but otherwise please keep the cards at home or in the car. Please DO allow them to pack their favorite book from home to use during our down time.
