#### **Public Comments**

Working to ensure the general public has the opportunity to attend Council meetings and offer public comment, to ensure that the Council can conduct its business, the following guidelines apply to all public comment.

- The Council will have two sign-up sheets at a table in the meeting room 15 minutes before the scheduled meeting for those wishing to speak on agenda items or non-agenda subjects. Individuals may sign up in person, or in advance or on our website, <a href="https://oregonstatefaircouncil.org/meetings-1">https://oregonstatefaircouncil.org/meetings-1</a>, <a href="mailto:in">in</a> advance of the meeting via email. Email requests should include the date the requester wishes to speak, the requester's name, phone number, and the agenda item or topic of their comments.
- Public comment on agenda items before the Council: individuals on the list
  will be called to testify before actions on these items are taken. On the signup sheet, list your name, address, and, the agenda item upon which you
  wish to be heard.
- Public Comment on Non-Agenda items during Oregon State Fair Council Meetings: list your name, address, and the subject matter upon which you wish to heard.
- You will have 3 minutes to testify.
- When you are called to come forward to speak, state and spell your name for the recorded record of the meeting.
- Council members may ask questions to clarify your testimony but will not
  engage in a discussion with you. Public Comment allows the Council and CEO
  to hear issues that interest our citizens but does not allow an opportunity for
  dialogue between the speaker, Council, or Administrators.
- If the Council determines that follow-up is necessary, you may be referred to the CEO or an item may be placed on a future Council agenda.
- If you wish to submit written testimony before or at the meeting, please provide 15 copies.
- The public may not use videos or PowerPoint presentations to accompany their testimony without prior approval by the Council Chair.
- Speakers are expected to address the Council without yelling, name calling, using abusive or foul language or other behavior or speech that negatively impact the efficiency of the Council meeting.

- Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was made by all parties present.
- Approval of Minutes:
  - Council Meeting of January 25<sup>th</sup> and February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024: Chair Loyal Burns stated that there were two sets of minutes; one Regular Council Minutes and one Special Council Minutes. Chair Loyal Burns asked for a motion to approve both minutes. Council Member Craig Smith motioned to approve both sets of minutes, and seconded by Council Member Vicki Berger to approve the minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously.
  - Council went into an Executive Meeting Executive Session under ORS 192.660(2)(h). The meeting convened at 1:40 pm.
  - Council resumed Public Meeting The meeting reconvened at 2:10 pm.

#### • Reports:

- O Council Chair's Report: Chair Loyal Burns had nothing to report.
- o CEO's Report: CEO Grewe-Powell clarified that at times she may have additional staff sit with her at the Council Meetings to provide background or facts to the Council and public. If another staff member gives a report, the CEO is still responsible for ensuring the accuracy and content of each report. CEO Grewe-Powell stated that there would be a change in procedure moving forward, all bank records will be provided to each Council Member at all Council meetings.

A financial summary was provided to the Council. Reflected on the P&L dated February 29, 2024, under the Expo Center Revenue, OSFEC has collected \$39,352.80 in parking fees. Since then, OSFEC has collected additional fees for a total of \$117,000.00. With the funds collected, OSFEC will begin replacing the gravel parking lot on 17<sup>th</sup> Street prior to the Oregon State Fair. CEO Grewe-Powell stated we will continue to access different areas needing attention.

OSFEC has met with the City of Salem to discuss plans for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Spectacular. Vendor recruitment has been posted.

Annual employee reviews were completed last week. Weekly fair planning meetings are underway. OSFEC will be announcing the Fair entertainment line up in May.

- Financials: Chair Loyal Burns moved to accept financial statements that were presented to the Council. Council Member Austin McGuigan motioned to accept the financial statements, and seconded by Vice Chair Joel Conder. The motion carried unanimously.
- Old Business: CEO Grewe-Powell recommended to the Council to withdraw the media policy while it is under further review. CEO Grewe-Powell anticipates presenting to the Council a revised policy in the near future. Council Member Austin McGuigan made a motion to rescind the media policy. The motion was seconded by Council Member Craig Smith. The motion carried unanimously.
