President – John Decker Meeting called to order at 9:03 am. Quorum present.

Rollin Gardner provided a Field Maintenance sheet handout and reported on the current condition of the field and other related items. The list will be emailed out and we encourage anyone interested to feel free to tackle any of the tasks. The feedback has been great since the runway was spread, seeded and rolled several weeks back. This is the first step of several to getting it where it really needs to be. Thanks to all of those who participated in that effort.

Due to Ronnie Scarborough's work schedule, he has decided to step down from the Chief Safety Officer position. New member, Joel Garza will now be the new safety officer and this will be reflected on the AMA website. Joel comes from flying clubs in the Northeast and has quite a bit of experience in this area.

It was brought to our attention again that the field perimeter gates have been found left open. It was agreed on to have combo locks put on these gates in an effort to help remember to close and lock them when done. The lock codes will match the bathroom codes.

When mowing the field, please follow the same track as the previous cut in order to start mapping out a defined area. Also when using the zero turn mower on the lowest setting, please try to use it only for the runway while continuing to use the older John Deere mower for the parking lot and pits.
