President – John Decker Meeting called to order on 9/25/2020 at 9:00am. Quorum present.

Old Business

A motion/second was made to change the existing By-Laws verbiage. All changes were passed and the updates will be applied and uploaded to the website.

New Business

The deposit was paid to the Nessler Center for this year's Christmas party. If Nessler decides to close due to Covid, we will have the party at the field clubhouse with a "potluck" dinner. Nessler is currently limiting their occupancy to 50%.

The 2021 board nominations will be held at the October meeting and all current members have decided to run again although all positions are open.

Rollin Gardner updated everyone on the field maintenance as follows:

- New a/c in the men's restroom.
- New microwave needed in the kitchen.
- Brian and others have done an excellent job on maintaining the mowers.
- The club mowers are not to be used to mow along the road down to the gate. Let Brian delegate or handle this mowing.
- Approximately 15 new fence posts, to be purchased by Glen and Rollin, will be installed on the north side of the field.
- All far side field gates will be chained and locked using the bathroom combo code.
- A new pilot's station will be added to the crosswind runway.

- John Decker has agreed to donate an electric power washer to be used to clean the mowers.
- Do not use Seafoam additive to any of the mower gas jugs. Brian will handle this.
- A concrete pad will be poured to use as a mower wash station.

Safety Officer, Tim Holmes reported the following:

- When taking off or landing with other planes already in the air, please announce your intentions to the other pilots.
- DO NOT arm any electric motors in the pit area.
- DO NOT take off from the taxi area.
- Upon landing, make sure your motor is dead or disarmed before crossing the “shut-down” line.

Joel Garza ordered a new windsock from Amazon and it will be replaced upon arrival.

Sand will be added at some point to the ends of the main runway.

Show and Tell:

- Rollin brought a Chipmunk, homemade paint stand along with several R/C Scale International magazines.
- Vince showed a plane balancing jig.
- Glen showed everyone a good method of adding panel lines, rib stitching and rivets to a scale plane.
