



EIFFEL TOWER

Capture the iconic landmark from various vantage points, such as Trocadéro Gardens for a classic frontal view, or from the Seine River banks for a scenic perspective.




LOUVRE MUSEUM

This ornate bridge is known for its elegant design, golden statues, and views of the Seine River and the Eiffel Tower.





NIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY




PEOPLE INTERACTION


